

## From the Desk of Deacon Mark

## **Families**

There are very few families that go through life without some type of trouble. It might be finances, illness, or any of a myriad of things that life puts in our path. Those who survive these trials are the ones who possess the great gifts of love and faith

Love and faith give us the ability to endure hardship, support each other in troubled times, and forgive each other when we fall. It makes us brave when we are frightened, and humble when we are self-assured. Families that have strong bonds of love and faith will persevere and come out stronger than when they began.

Today we celebrate the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. If there ever was a model family of love and faith it would be the Holy Family.

The angel asks Mary if she will be the Mother of Jesus. This decision could have many negative effects on her yet her love of God and faith compelled her to say yes.

Joseph learns that Mary is with Child and decides to divorce her quietly to protect her from shame. He is visited by an angel in a dream who says that Mary conceived by the Holy Spirit and to accept her. His love for God and faith gave him the courage to accept Mary and the scorn of his neighbors.

Forced to comply with Roman's census decree they travel many miles from Nazareth to Bethlehem only to find there is no place for them. Worst of all Mary gives birth in the stable amid the animals. Their faith and love for God and each other allows them to accept the situation.

Shortly after the birth of Jesus, Joseph is warned of Herod's plan to kill the Child and that they should flee to Egypt. Their faith in God's message and love for their Child leads them on a long journey to a foreign land.

The greatest challenge they faced is raising the Son of God. How do you parent the one who created you? What can you teach Him? Again, it is their love and faith that guide them in this mission.

When our families are facing difficulties let us look at the Holy Family, and the troubles they endured, and learn from them. May our families be filled with a strong love and faith in God and each other.

May God shower His blessings on you, your families, and all people of good will.

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,



I pray that, accompanied by the Lord, we may learn to be sources of encouragement for each other on the journey.



## **Have You Considered eGiving for Your Sunday Contributions?**

There is a "Donate" button on our parish website that you can use for your Sunday donations. This option takes you to the Give Central website, where you can sign up for a regular schedule of contributing that YOU set up. The schedule is completely up to you, and there are several frequency options including weekly, bi-weekly, monthly and quarterly.

You can also sign up for continued Electronic Giving for your Sunday Stewardship contributions through the parish, either by direct debit from your bank account or credit card, on a monthly or weekly basis. A form is available on our parish website or can be emailed/mailed to you at your request.

After signing up for electronic giving, never worry about forgetting your envelope again! It continues your support to Prince of Peace when you are out of town, on vacation or unable to attend Mass.

Parishioners who donate electronically to the Sunday collection receive a quarterly envelope packet, which contains envelopes for any special collections (i.e. St. Vincent de Paul, Holy Day & Archdiocesan collections) rather than the full monthly packet you receive now. Providing you with this new quarterly packet results in a savings to the parish.




