This weekend I invite you to journey with us as we begin the holy season of Lent. This Wednesday, we celebrate Ash Wednesday, a day that marks the beginning of our preparation for Easter - a time to renew our faith and draw closer to the Lord.

Ash Wednesday is a special moment in our liturgical calendar. It is a day of humility, reflection, and grace. 


