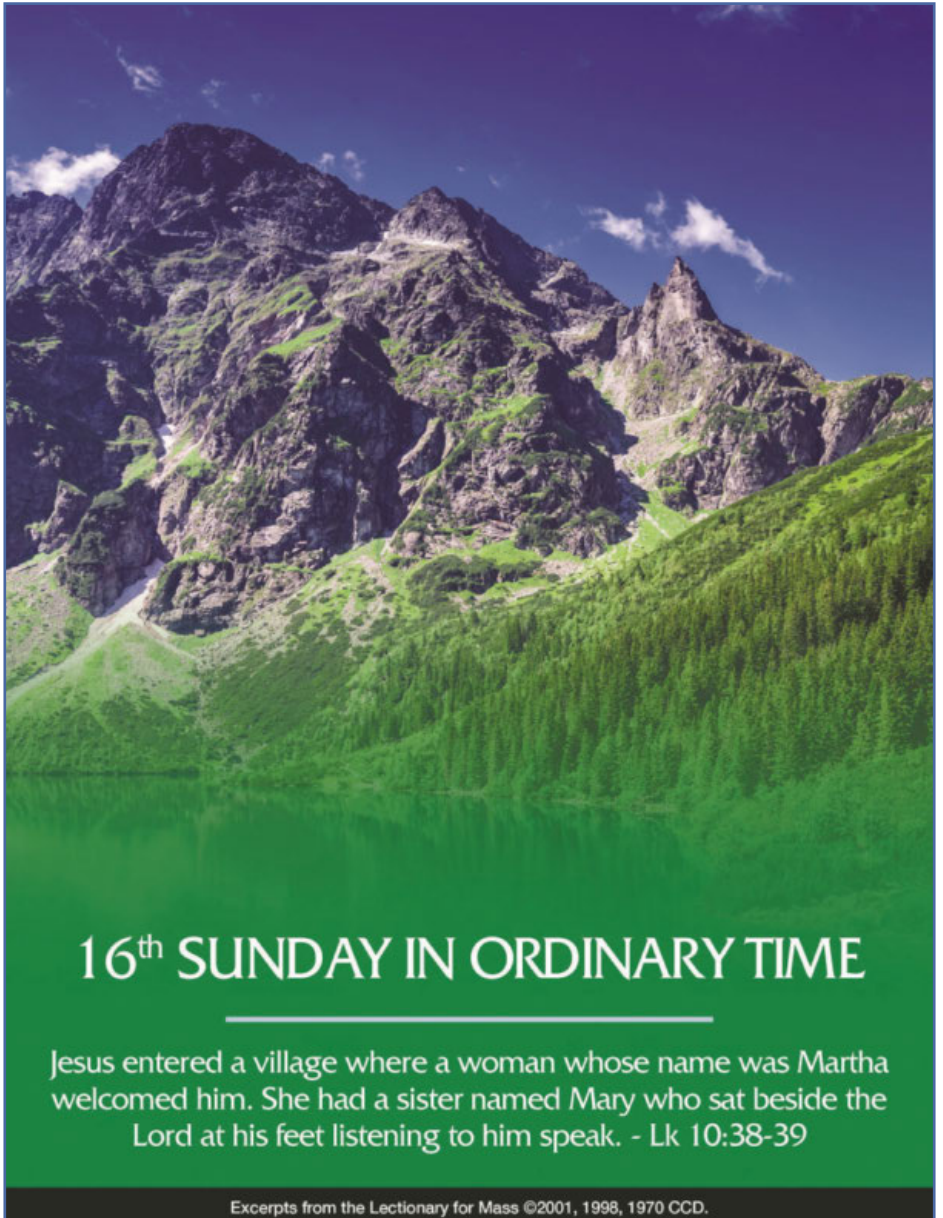

- ◆ We had 3 funerals last week, 2 on Monday at St. Gertrude and 1 on Wednesday at St. Ann. Thanks to everyone who sang, served and attended. The families of the deceased were very appreciative . . . and you made me a very proud pastor!
- ◆ With Fr. Bernie gone, I am doing the 5 weekend Masses: 2 on Saturday evening and 3 back-to-back on Sunday. Your help and understanding have been a blessing! At times I'm scrambling, and by the end of the day my voice is gone—again, thanks for your patience and understanding. I must admit, as I settle into a rhythm it's getting easier for me; I hope for you, too. I also want to thank Deacons Charlie and Dave who are preaching more on Sundays, giving me a bit of a break.

A couple of things to keep in mind: next Saturday, June 23rd, I will have 6pm Mass at St. Ann's, in celebration of their Feast Day (the actual feast of St. Ann is July 26). I will need to leave immediately after St. Gertrude's 4:30pm Mass, and there will be no St. Ann Confessions before Mass that evening. After the 6pm Mass we will have ice cream and some kids activities—all are invited to this *Parish Family* celebration!

Also, as you may have heard or read in last week's bulletin, St. Gertrude's PSR will merge with St. Ann's PSR starting Wednesday, August 24th. There simply were not enough children enrolled in St. Gertrude's PSR to make it a vibrant program (only 9 children signed up for 8 grades) - and it was too late in the year to push registration, as books needed to be ordered asap. Fortunately St. Ann's PSR is the same night and time (Wednesday 6:30pm), they have room, and they are only 4 miles away. God is good to once again provide for us—together we are always better.

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

Be Ready for God to "Stop By"

In my experience, most people can be divided into two groups: those who are old enough to remember when you kept food on hand for company, and those who aren't.

For those of you in the latter group, let me explain. Before text messaging and social media made us all unconditionally, mercilessly reachable, people would do this thing called "stopping by." They would be passing by a friend's house, maybe on the way home from work or shopping, and they would just ... stop. With no warning. No notice whatsoever. "I was just in the neighborhood," they would say. I remember my mother and I would do this on many a Saturday. It wasn't an everyday occurrence, but it was common enough that you had to be ready.

"Crazy," you might exclaim. "People just appeared on your doorstep? How did you cope with the uncertainty?" Well, most of us had moms who kept a little something on hand to eat or drink that was extra nice, just in case anyone stopped by. That way, we were always ready. Today's readings are about a lot of things: prayer, hope, redemptive suffering. They're about what it means to be a Christian, and not just what it means to do Christian things.

Most of all, though, they're about readiness. If God showed up at your door, would you be ready for Him? Would you be ready for what He gives you, or what He takes away? Would you be ready for Him to interrupt the plans you have for yourself? To disrupt the idea you carry in your mind of what a servant or a steward is supposed to be?

Read your Bible. Say your rosary. Go to Mass. Get to Confession. Talk to God — every day, not just when you think you need Him. That way, you are always ready.— Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS

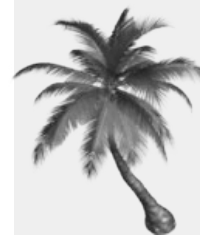
