ALL THINGS NEW YOUNG ADULT SURVEY

Based on the results of the Discipleship Maker Index (DMI) that was offered in the spring of this year, seeing an increase in young adult involvement is the top priority of the archdiocese. In response, the All Things New Team, the Office of Young Adult Ministry and the Young Adult Ministry Subcommittee have created a survey to gather feedback from young adults.

All young adults whether single, discerning, married, priest or religious, with or without children, ages 18-39 are encouraged to fill out the survey. Here they may anonymously share their beliefs and interests, their needs, their experience in parishes, and their hopes for the future if the church in St. Louis. Responses are due by September 12th with a report being published in October.

What is the DMI?

This past Spring, parishioners here at St. Ann and across the Archdiocese of St. Louis were invited to share their thoughts, reflect on their spiritual growth as well as provide parish leadership with invaluable insight regarding their parish's strengths and opportunities through a survey, the Disciple Maker Index (DMI). The DMI survey is designed to capture information regarding attitudes and beliefs, relationship and satisfaction, participation, and demographics using a quantitative tool that can be used for benchmarking and trending information.


Key Observations:

- 82% of our parishioners stated that they are very happy with our Pastor and would recommend him to a friend.
- ♦ 86% of parishioners who responded to the DMI agree or strongly agree, that we are a very welcoming parish and they are made to feel very accepted. This shows that we still have that spirit with us after all these years. St. Ann has always been a welcoming parish in so many ways.
- Over 80% of our parishioners agree or strongly agree that they are actively growing in their faith from the preaching that is done at Mass by Fr. Carl and Deacon Dave and feel that the experience they have at Mass each day/week helps them grow in their faith.
- Communication seems to be one of the key drivers for our parish. 94%
 of the parishioners agree or strongly agree that our communication is
 right on tract. We have many different avenues for getting information
 out.
- What we need most growth in is evangelization. This can happen in many different ways for us. Ways we can better do this is to learn how to share our personal stories of our faith and stories of Jesus of with others. Also encourage the discussion of entering the priest hood or other religious orders.


