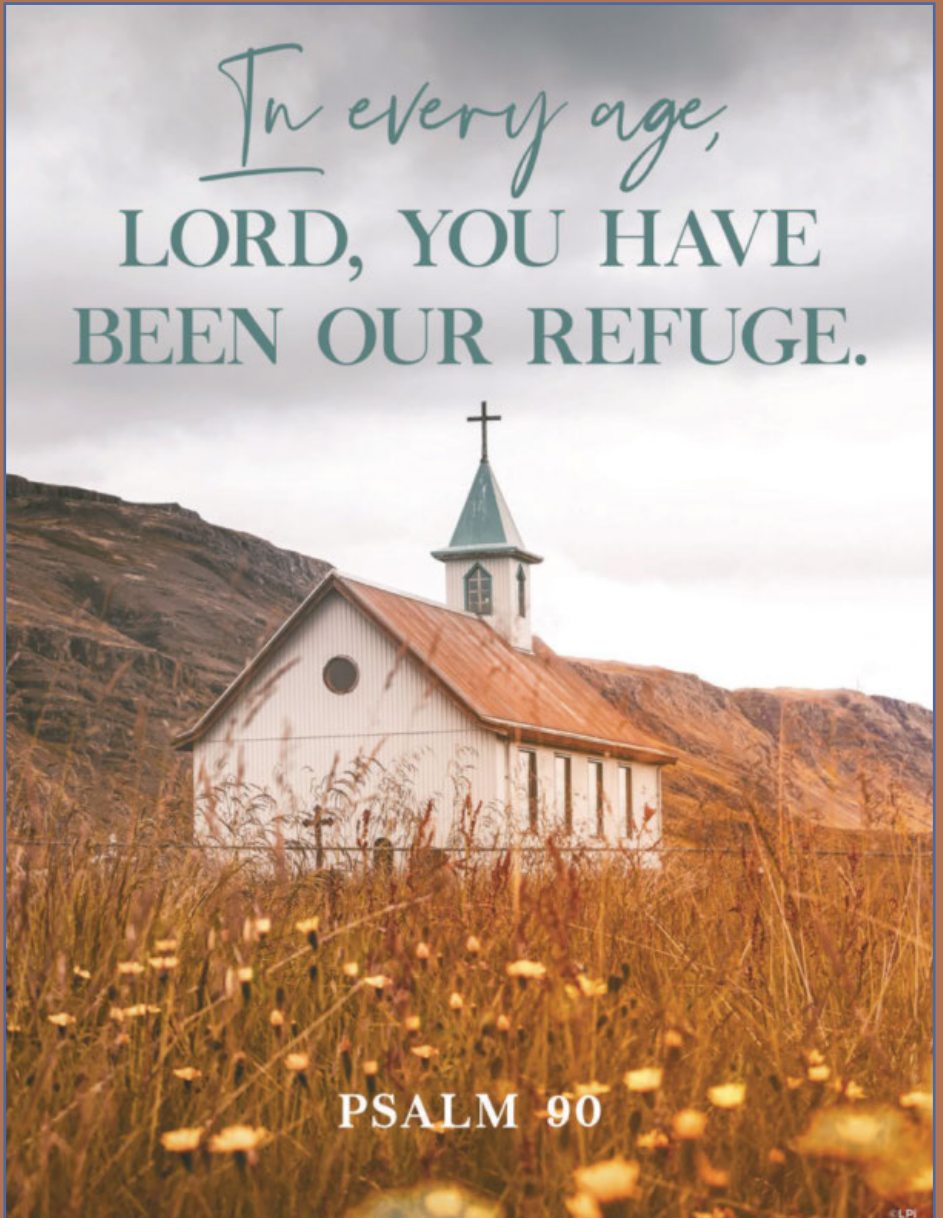

*May those of us who are now retired always remember that we still make a valuable contribution to our Church and our world by our prayers and deeds of charity.*

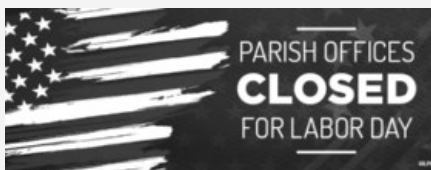
