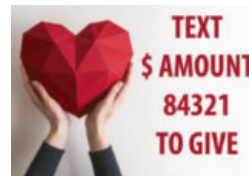

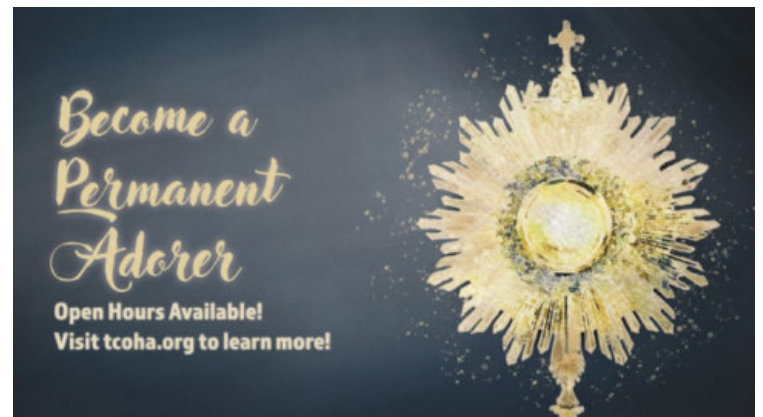

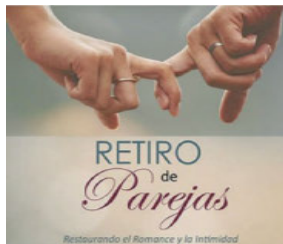

## Bautismo del Señor

Un año ha quedado atrás, empezamos el año nuevo con nuevas esperanzas y nuevos bríos, nuevas metas y nuevas intenciones. Hemos dejado atrás un año que fue difícil para muchos de nosotros, pero con la gracia y la bendición de Dios nuestro Señor aquí vamos de nuevo. Nuestras nuevas esperanzas y metas se deberían destacar más como nos las relatan las lecturas del día de hoy.

En la primera lectura el profeta Isaías, proclama la venida del Señor por todo lo alto y describe lo que Juan Bautista muchos años más tarde anunció al pueblo judío, en el cual el mismo sería protagonista y testigo presencial. 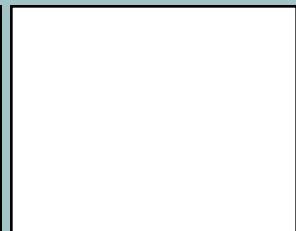

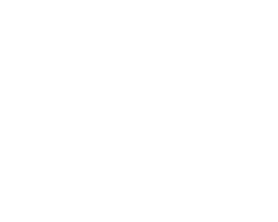
