

## SACRAMENTAL CELEBRATIONS

**Baptism** - Take place after the 10:30 A.M. Mass on Sunday. A class may be required prior to baptism. Call 608-254-8381 x2 to make arrangements.

**Sacrament of Matrimony** - Arrangements must be made with the Parish Priest (608-254-8381 x2) at least six months prior to anticipated date of wedding.

*Care of the Sick* - Communion will be brought to the homebound and the sick who are confined to their homes each week. For new additions to the Communion List, please call the Parish Office (608-254-8381 x3) by Wednesday noon.

**Sacrament of the Sick** - Will be administered to all of those seriously ill, those about to have major surgery, and any of the elderly of the Parish requesting it. Call 608-254-8381 x2 to arrange an anointing.



A ninety-day spiritual exercise for men based on three pillars: prayer, asceticism, and fraternity.

#### **PRAYER**

During Exodus 90 you will build up a habit of daily prayer. You will commit to praying a holy hour each day. If you can't do an entire holy hour on a given day, do as much as you can with a minimum of twenty minutes of silent prayer both speaking to and actively listening to the Lord.

#### **ASCETICISM**

The ascetic disciplines laid out in Exodus 90 help each man to detach from the things of the world. Exodus 90 is equally an exercise in prayer as it is in asceticism, and in asceticism as it is in fraternity. Just as we need all three to live out the Christian life, so too we need all three to take up Exodus 90.

#### **FRATERNITY**

During Exodus 90 you will practice fraternity with 4-6 other men in your area. This is not a warm and cuddly, "I'm ok, you're ok, so we're all ok" type of fraternity. This is an authentic, "the time is now," knees on the marble, type of fraternity. A fraternity where accountability brings forth authentic masculinity. The Christian life is not easy. You need brothers and they need you.

Begins on Monday, January 17th and ends on Sunday, April 17th - Easter Sunday



Sunday, January 23rd, 2022 has been designated *National Sanctity of Human Life Day*. This day is a result of a presidential proclamation under former President Ronald Reagan. In 2019-2020, nearly 7,000 children per week lost their lives through medical and surgical abortions (according to the Guttmacher Institute, the independent research arm of Planned Parenthood). All life, born and unborn, is sacred, unique and unrepeatable. Please pray, not just on this day, but every day that abortion will end and all life will be valued.

This includes all non-baptized faith formation students and students who have not made their first confession or received first communion who are older than second grade.




# **Family Catechesis**
