


SAINT CECILIA

SACRAMENTAL CELEBRATIONS

Baptism - Take place after the 10:30 A.M. Mass on Sunday. A class may be required prior to baptism. Call 608-254-8381 x2 to make arrangements.

Sacrament of Matrimony - Arrangements must be made with the Parish Priest (608-254-8381 x2) at least six months prior to anticipated date of wedding.

Care of the Sick - Communion will be brought to the homebound and the sick who are confined to their homes each week. For new additions to the Communion List, please call the Parish Office (608-254-8381 x3) by Wednesday noon.

Sacrament of the Sick - Will be administered to all of those seriously ill, those about to have major surgery, and any of the elderly of the Parish requesting it. Call 608-254-8381 x2 to arrange an anointing.

These are the Elected and Appointed Officers within Our Lady of the Dells Council:



SANCTITY OF LIFE SUNDAY Sunday, January 23rd, 2022

Sunday, January 23rd, 2022 has been designated *National Sanctity of Human Life Day*. This day is a result of a presidential proclamation under former President Ronald Reagan. In 2019-2020, nearly 7,000 children per week lost their lives through medical and surgical abortions (according to the Guttmacher Institute, the independent research arm of Planned Parenthood). All life, born and unborn, is sacred, unique and unrepeatable. Please pray, not just on this day, but every day that abortion will end and all life will be valued.

St. Cecilia Pro-Life Commission will have *free* materials in addition to items that can be checked out in the gathering space at all the weekend masses.
