



#### St. Ann's Marriage Ministry

St. Ann's Sodality has a marriage ministry for our parish called the "Mary's Prayer Marriage Ministry". The Blessed Mother, Our Lady of Good Counsel, is our help and guide, and we ask her to intercede for our newly engaged and married couples to help them keep God at the center of their marriage. The first phase of this ministry involved creating gift bags of items for couples being married in Immaculate Conception Church throughout the year. This Marriage Blessing Gift Bag includes a book of devotions for married couples, crucifix, rosary, family prayer card, miraculous medal, divine mercy bracelet, and a wedding blessings bookmark. The bags are blessed and then given to the couples by Father before their wedding to help them on their spiritual journey together as a married couple. We also assign a prayer partner to each engaged couple to pray for them throughout their engagement and their first year of married life.

The second part of the ministry is a marriage and family resource center with resource information and a CD library. Most of the CD's are from Focus on the Family, and the materials are located in the pamphlet rack on the wall outside the choir room. Parishioners can take copies of the resource materials. The CD's can be taken to listen to using the honor system, and then returned to the rack when finished. These are our only copies of the CD's, so we hope folks please remember to return them!
