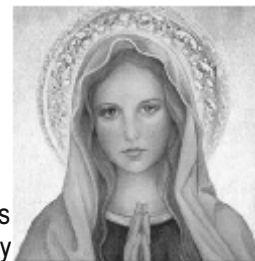

### **REFLECTIONS OF A PLC—**

Jesus reveals the mystery of the cross to his disciples and their first discussion is about who is greatest. If this doesn't sum up the world in which we live, I'm not sure what would. How often do we know of others or even within our own hearts the pious pride that wells up inside when presented the beauty of the faith? Sometimes we mistake ourselves thinking it is all just for us individually.
