My family and I want to wish you a very merry Christmas. We have many years of family traditions, memories, and warmth created around the holidays, we are blessed to share them with the St. Joseph family this year.

The past several Fridays it has been up to Fr. Dave and I to reflect on the reality of the Holy Family during our Adoration series. For me this has been a great project and has really shown me a real depth into each person as I completed research and much reading. There are a few things that I think are worth highlighting from all that we have shared over the past three Fridays as we look towards the great solemnity of Christmas.

As you study the Holy Family one of the first things you will realize looking into Sacred Scripture is that there really isn't a lot on the early years aside from the Nativity of Jesus, flight into Egypt, & return. Another thing you will notice in Matthews Gospel is that every time we find St. Joseph though he does not speak, he is usually sleeping. Funny enough there are statues dedicated to a slumbering St. Joseph. Pope Francis has one on his desk! The most interesting perspective I found is one shared by many saints particularly St. Josemaria Escriva in observing the silence over a majority of the life of Jesus. In a word, living an ordinary life with Mary & Joseph. Some call this the "Making Holy" of ordinary life and ordinary things. I like to try to imagine a simple day spent at the household of Mary & Joseph. Laughter, work, prayer, and play. Things that we all should find important these days as we come closer to the holidays of Christmas and Mary the Mother of God.




