### St. Joseph's Corner

#### **Reflections of the Parish Life Coordinator**

The Wedding at Cana is an important event in the life of Christ particularly as relates to his mother Mary. There are many reasons for this. The first is that everything we know about Mary preserves something that we know about Christ. Think about this for a minute, what if someone erroneously tried to say that Jesus was fully divine and not human at all? We can easily say, well, wait a minute, Jesus has a mother and she gave brith to him, doesn't that make him human?

These arguments can go much deeper but the illustration here is clear. What we know about Mary safeguards and teaches us something about Jesus. Not to mention in today's Gospel we have a peek into the relationship between Jesus and Mary. Sometimes it is interpreted as tension, but when Jesus tells his mother that it is not yet his hour, and uses the honorific "woman" he is responding in royal language. Woman as used here is actually a honorific, unfortunately we do not have a similar word in English. When Jesus refers to "his hour" he is saying that it is not time for him to suffer and die yet, it is not time for his public ministry to begin. Yet, Mary tells the stewards, as she tells all of us as her spiritual children, to "do whatever [Jesus] tells you."

How are we Mary's spiritual Children? Recall from the Gospel of John when Jesus tells his disciple John and thereby all Christians to "behold your mother" and Mary to "behold your son." Today say an extra Hail Mary prayer for the intention that we may be better sons and daughters of God and that we may "do whatever [Jesus] tells us"

As a final note, please pray for Christian Unity! We ought to pray just as Jesus prays, "may they all be one." Many may think that our focus on Mary may be a source of division but in some ways learning about the parents of Jesus teaches us something about Jesus, just as learning about your parents would teach us something about you! As Christians we are to regard each other with warmth and hospitality building up the good, true, and beautiful encouraging one another in Christ!




