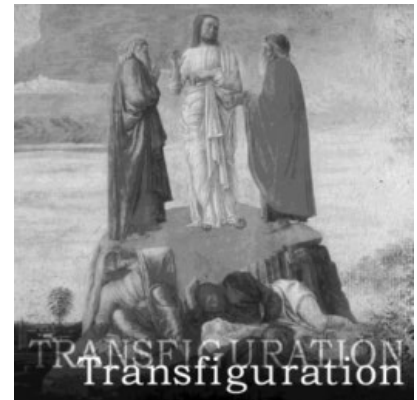

## St. Joseph's Corner

### Reflections of the Parish Life Coordinator

This weekend we find ourselves faced with a miraculous event in the life of Christ. Jesus promises certain disciples that they will not pass before they witness the glory of the kingdom, and in this event, his promise is fulfilled. A mere eight days after the confession of St. Peter's faith, Jesus reveals his glory to his closest friends. These same friends are the ones who later will remain closest to Our Lord, in the depth of his suffering in the garden of Gethsemane. In some ways foreshadowing the coming suffering, death, and resurrection; in other ways revealing the glory of heaven. In many ways, it shows to us for the first time just how ungraspable the glory of heaven is; how our words, and the words of St. Peter falter at the glory that is revealed. Also, that our understanding of who God is, is limited so much by our words and weak understanding; how our intellect falls short in grasping the fullness of God. This is an important realization to have in our lives as we enter deeper into the spiritual life. God does not fit into boxes. He reveals pieces of himself throughout the Old Testament, then says everything he wishes to say through the life and witness of Jesus Christ. And yet, God is still a mystery. This comes to the puzzle of handing on the faith. You know in our days of old, memorization was key, and even today memorization is very important. The Baltimore Catechism was an amazing revolutionary tool. Yet, one thing that failed in that age, was understanding that God is so much bigger than what small amount we know; that our prayer needs to also be organic and deep. In order to understand suffering and pain, even and especially from people in the Church, we must know not just what the Church teaches, but the character of a Christian life. As an example: how to suffer well, how to experience our own Gethsemane. The answer is in the transfiguration and life of Christ. As his glory is revealed, he reveals not just the beauty of God, but the depth of his love and what it means to love. This is a lesson of the heart as well as the mind, which is why Catechesis is so critical not just in knowledge, but in family and in the school of love and compassion. May we not only learn more about the gospels, but live them out as witnesses to the beauty and glory of God.

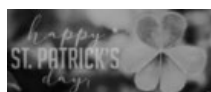
Are you interested in becoming a Eucharistic Minister? Please call the Parish Office to apply.

### Covid Restriction Changes

Covid restrictions have been lifted, We are going back to some practices we traditionally had before Covid hit.

For communion, we are welcome to form two lines in the center aisle to receive the Eucharist. If you are unable to do so, or you are uncomfortable doing so, a Eucharistic Minister will come around to you. Please remain standing to flag an Eucharistic Minister.

We are welcome to offer a handshake for the Sign of Peace. Please respect those who may not be comfortable with this gesture.



### Fasting & Abstinence

Good Friday is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

### A reflection on Lenten Fasting

If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night), as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus; to prepare ourselves to share more fully, and to celebrate more readily, his Resurrection.

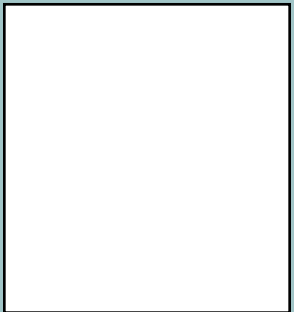
