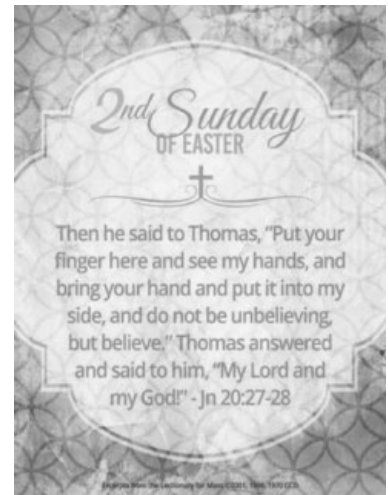

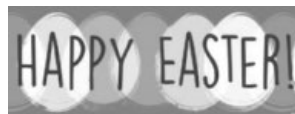

## St. Joseph's Corner

### Reflections of the Parish Life Coordinator

What does it take for you to believe? The disciples on the way to Emmaus encountered a mysterious Christ whom they didn't recognize. They received the best bible study ever, their hearts were on fire but it wasn't until Jesus prayed the Eucharistic prayers that he was fully revealed to them, and they believed. In the gathering described in this Sunday's gospel, likely present were those two disciples who had just come back from their experience at Emmaus. Yet, here we are with Thomas who missed all of those experiences, and is relying on the word of his brother Peter and the disciples. He exclaimed that the only way that he will believe is if he puts his finger in the wounds of Christ. Jesus indeed came before them yet again, fulfilling Thomas' request, but also teaching a lesson. Not everyone is going to be blessed with a mystical encounter with Christ in such a way that we may put our finger in his wound, and believe. In some ways, this is a rebuke of not just Thomas, but all of us who take for granted the beautiful witness of so many lives who share the love of Christ with us. Many of us will indeed encounter Christ mystically, just veiled in the Holy Eucharist. How will you now approach the Eucharist seeing Thomas' reaction? There are many who during Mass keep the pious tradition of praying silently Thomas' exclamation at the elevation of the Eucharist, "My Lord and My God!" What will it take for you to believe in the resurrection? It is the Christian faith, hope, and love that is given witness by so many for which we often take for granted. As they say, bad news sells papers, but we are a people of the good news; let's act like it!



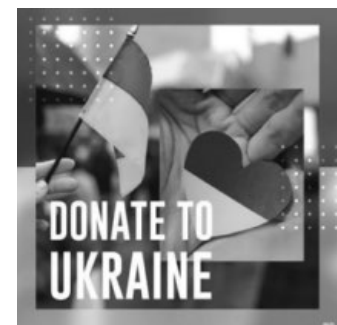

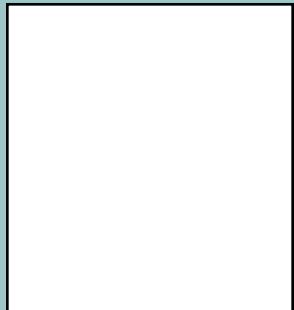
