Ramblings of the Pastor

There were dozens of applicants waiting to be interviewed for the position of telegraph operator. Their conversations competed against the dots and dashes of the telegraph. Another applicant entered the room and stands there quietly for a moment listening attentively to the dots and dashes, he walked to a door marked "Private" and knocked. The personnel director opened the door and announced to the others, "You may all go now; this applicant has the job." Angry, the others demanded an explanation. At that, the director said, "Listen!", then they all heard the dots and dashes, repeating over and over the same message, "If you hear this, come in; the job is yours." This story challenges us to listen. God is constantly speaking to us, but, like the crowd of applicants, we are not always listening. Today's gospel describes how the Risen Jesus is revealed to his observant and listening apostles, through a miraculous catch of fish. God speaks to us through scripture, prayer, and the Church, as well as through the world around us. Are we listening? Do we contemplate and pray about what we hear at Mass, or read in scripture? God also often tries to speak to us through our conscience as we contemplate our actions, nudging us toward acts of love. We need to give our attention to God in prayer and our time in church. God is calling to all of us, like he did Peter and the other disciples. Can we say, "yes Lord I love you" with our words and deeds?

St. Joseph's Corner

Reflections of the Parish Life Coordinator

In today's Gospel we hear again about the coming of Jesus to the Apostles. No doubt the disciples of Jesus who met him on the road to Emmaus had returned with their story of encountering him on the way. Many times I get asked by young people, "Why doesn't Jesus just appear to everyone in the world? Wouldn't that be so much more efficient?" It may seem so at outset, but as we read the stories of Jesus' appearances after the resurrection, one thing becomes clear. Consider that most times when Jesus appears, he isn't recognized. When Jesus is recognized, it is realized in fear; and this is for people who spent three years of their lives intensely following and spending virtually every moment with Jesus as their mentor and teacher.

Faith in Jesus only grows when he is encountered in the Eucharist. It was in the "breaking of the bread," as the Mass was called in those days, in which Jesus was revealed. If this is the case for the disciples, how much more is it the case for us? Jesus knew we would need the Eucharist to continue the mission and work that he has invited us into. Jesus always intended to create a community of people, founded and fed by the sacraments or mystical encounters with his grace. When the Disciples were filled by the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, finally fed by the Body and Blood of our Blessed Lord, they could go forth to proclaim the Gospel as they were empowered by the Holy Spirit. May we continue to strive to encounter Jesus in the mystery of the Holy Eucharist!

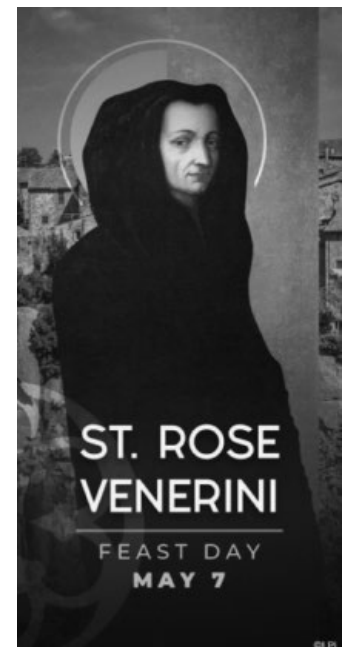

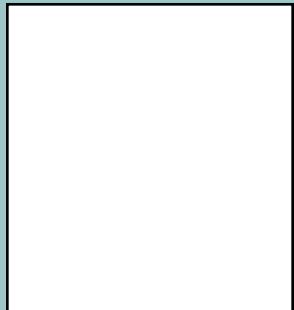
