Reflections of the Parish Life Coordinator

Happy Mother's day! Women both in the Church and in the world have an essential role, which must be lifted up. Both spiritual mothers and natural mothers are essential in the life of the Church. The Blessed Mother gave birth to Christ Jesus and she gives birth to the Church at Pentecost. Mary is both the mother of Jesus and our spiritual mother, showing us that both roles of motherhood are sacred. It was Mary's very close cooperation with the Holy Spirit which drew her into the heart of God, and therefore a blessing to those she encountered like her cousin Elizabeth. In today's Gospel, Jesus talks about the way in which he is the gate, he is the door. Mary not only knows Christ by his voice, but she knows the promptings of the Holy Spirit in the depths of her heart in a way that the Apostles don't understand, until the ascension of Christ. I know in my own life, the greatest witness of faith is my own Grandmother, who exampled to me the love of God and the strength of spirit that I would carry with me into my adult life. Her love of the Rosary inspired my own love of and devotion to the Blessed Mother. Too often we take for granted the important witness of grandmothers who are evangelists in a way that no one else can rival or replace. Beyond the witness of Grandmothers, it is important that mothers are represented in important levels in the Church as decisions are made. This begins with women and mothers volunteering to join important positions on Parish Council and leading lay associations of women such as Ladies of Charity, Altar and Rosary, and other such apostolates. Spiritual motherhood is a key gift in the Church that is needed at the highest levels. I want to thank all the women in my life for the important witness and the gift of themselves, which helped me to grow and understand who I am, and the call that God has placed on each of our lives.
