## St. Joseph's Corner

### Reflections of the Parish Life Coordinator

The Ascension! Jesus Ascends into the glory of heaven, but not before imparting his final instructions to the disciples. Just as Jesus had at Emmaus (Lk 24:19-27). Jesus makes it clear, reminding again the reason for his suffering and death was salvation, and the freedom that his grace brings. Then, Jesus proclaims that the freedom of his grace is to be applied to all those the disciples encounter, liberating souls from the slavery and hurt of sin. Jesus reminds the disciples of how they had witnessed the healing balm of his ministry of mercy and love. Finally, Jesus confirms in them the promise of the advocate who will strengthen them in the impossible task of bringing freedom to all people by virtue of his grace. The task is impossible on human terms, but with the Holy Spirit, all things are possible! This is why, as Christians, we need the Holy Spirit! To have the strength, fortitude, and loving patience to love the unlovable in ourselves, in our families, and in others. Without this grace, we often get hung up on strong emotions, passions, and perceived fairness, or even politics. Christ is above these things, which are passing and futile. The freedom Jesus offers us is for all peoples, as "there is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free person, there is not male and female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus." The Holy Spirit is what makes this possible. Pray today that we may be faithful to Jesus' parting words, that we might bring the healing of his grace into every part of our lives, and in the lives of those we encounter.

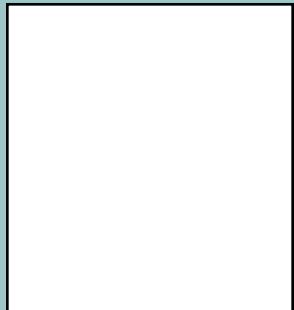
