Congratulation to Bishop Zinkula

Vatican City Press Release July 26, 2023

Pope Francis on Wednesday appointed Bishop Thomas Zinkula of Davenport to lead Iowa's Metropolitan Archdiocese of Dubuque. Zinkula, 66, has led the Davenport Diocese in southeast Iowa since 2017. The Archdiocese of Dubuque has been run by an apostolic administrator since the April 4 resignation of Archbishop Michael O. Jackels, for health reasons. Jackels led the archdiocese for 10 years. The Archdiocese of Dubuque serves over 190,000 Catholics across 17,403 square miles in north central and northeast Iowa.

Ramblings of the Pastor

In 1941, Sergeant Ward was awarded the Victoria Cross for climbing out onto the wing of his bomber, at 13,000 feet, to extinguish a fire in the engine. Impressed by his heroics, Churchill summoned the shy sergeant to his office. Ward, struck dumb with awe, was unable to answer a few questions. Churchill with compassion said, "You must feel very humble and awkward in my presence." "Sir, Yes, Sir," managed Ward. "Then you can imagine how humble and awkward I feel in yours," replied Churchill. That's how Peter, James and John must have felt, not knowing how to react to Jesus, who was shining in his divinity conversing with two of the greatest prophets in Jewish Scripture. At Mass, the Host may not shine with God's divinity, but it fully contains it. At each Mass we are presented with the opportunity to climb that mountain and adore Christ in all his glory and worship him. The Apostles were amazed to see Christ in glory. Are we amazed to see ordinary bread and wine be transformed into the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of our Risen Lord? The Mass is the greatest prayer of the Church because we can worship the Divine presence and join our sacrifice with Christ's one sacrifice at Calvary. The worthy reception of Communion is a bonus, not the purpose of Mass. This is why the Church requires Mass attendance even for those unworthy of receiving our Lord in Holy Communion. For over a thousand years, the laity rarely received communion but attended Mass weekly. There are graces in abundance by our active participation at Mass, especially by joining our daily sacrifices with Christ's sacrifice on the Cross. That is the real reason to come to Mass, to worship the real and enduring presence of Christ in the sacrament, and joining our daily sacrifices to His. Let us remember at every Mass, that the real presence of God in the Eucharist is the real reason we should feel good to be there, as the disciples were at the transfiguration.

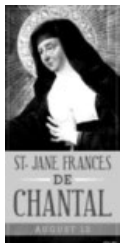

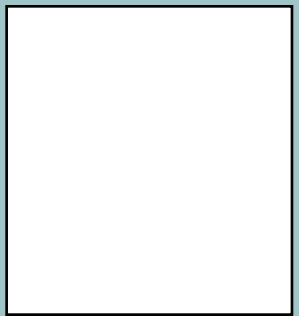

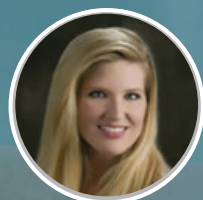
