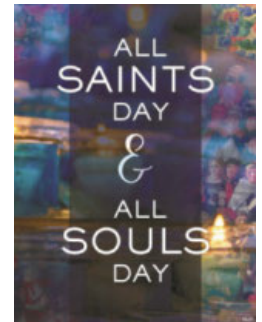

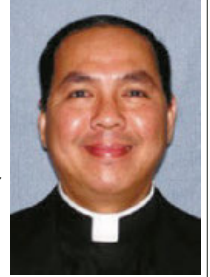

**Welcome to Fr. Hai's Corner**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



Although today's Gospel recounts the healing of Bartimaeus' physical blindness, the story is a summons for each of us to be healed of our spiritual blindness. Spiritual blindness, an effect of sin, clouds our ability to perceive who we are and who God is. Paradoxically, Bartimaeus' spiritual eyesight is clear; he recognizes who Jesus is and he sees his own desperate need for Jesus' help. For us, however, sin acts like dust, obstructing our vision and preventing us from perceiving God's presence. We find it difficult to recognize God in other people and in the sacraments; and we likewise become incapable of perceiving ourselves as God sees us. If we wish to have our spiritual eyesight restored, we would do well to imitate Bartimaeus' humble, confident prayer: "Master, I want to see." Acknowledging our need before God and begging for his help, we invite him to heal our hearts, so that we, like Bartimaeus, may follow Jesus "on the way."

Choose a regular time to take advantage of the two opportunities for healing we've discussed – confession and Eucharistic adoration. If you do not already go to confession regularly, consider making it a monthly commitment. Finally, set aside time this week to visit Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, either in Eucharistic adoration or before the tabernacle in your church. Try visiting him weekly – and then watch how your time in his presence transforms you. (Grow + Go)

**Synod on Synodality**- This month Bishops from around the world gather in Rome for the Synod.

**Part 6: What is going to change?**

On the one hand, nothing will change: the Catholic Church is not going to replace our Trinitarian beliefs with a Binitarian creed, we are not going to reduce the Eucharist to an exclusively symbolic ritual, and there will be no new papal teaching that Baptism is no longer important. On the other hand, Pope Francis has asked the whole church to engage in discerning God's will, and we cannot be in the business of predetermining what God has called us to. While we can't predict ahead of time what will happen, the three themes of the synod are helpful guideposts. At all levels, from the Vatican to the diocese to the parish, there should be a deeper communion among people rooted in God, wider participation in the life and discernment of the Church, and an urgent missionary focus by everyone in the pews.

**Thoughts of a PA  
30th Sunday in Ordinary Time  
Cycle B**

If you remember last week, James and John had asked Jesus for glory with seats at the right and left hand of Jesus in Heaven. Jesus gave these disciples a lesson about what it means to be a disciple in the kingdom of God. Discipleship in the kingdom is not about places of honor and glory, but about service and having faith in Jesus and following him! This is an example made in this week's Gospel with Bartimaeus. Unlike James and John in last week's Gospel, the faith of Bartimaeus in Jesus is simple. He does not want a place of honor and glory. He simply wants to see. And he believes that Jesus of Nazareth can restore his sight. When his sight was returned to him, Bartimaeus followed Jesus. Not just along the road where he had sat as a beggar, but in discipleship, faith, and service. In every aspect, Bartimaeus can now see the way. Not only is Bartimaeus healed of his blindness, but he is also given spiritual sight by recognizing Jesus as the true son of God. He recognizes his divine nature and has absolute trust that Jesus can heal him. His faith is rewarded. Bartimaeus can see that Jesus is the Way. He is also the **only one**, healed by Jesus who follows him.
