One of the things that older pastors and younger priests occasionally quarrel about is the proper balance between work and prayer. I know one pastor who complains that his younger associate ignores the people and the parish because he wants to spend more time in prayer. And the young priest complains that the pastor gives him too much work to do and no time to pray. The Lord's words this Sunday speak into this tension with an image that can help us find a proper balance between life and prayer.

Jesus says, **“For every tree is known by its fruit. For people do not pick figs from thorn bushes, nor do they gather grapes from brambles”** (Luke 6:44). When we are deeply rooted and cultivating our relationship with Jesus, we are going to bear the fruit of that love in our lives. No fruit, no good prayer. How do we know that we are praying well? We are experiencing concrete fruits of love for others in our lives.

Someone who prays well will, sooner or later, burst forth the “figs” and “grapes” of acts of love. But without concrete commitment to deeds of selfless service to others, our prayer time is as useless as thorn bushes and brambles. Let's recommit ourselves to be men and women of prayer *and* service. And hopefully the pastors will help their associates to pray *and* serve fruitfully...with minimal quarreling.

"LIVING IN THE DIVINE WILL" CLASSES ARE BEING OFFERED AT ST. JOHN'S

Father Luke Krzanowski of La Salette Shrine in Twin Lakes, WI has been kind enough to help celebrate Masses at St. John's when Fr. Jacek is out of town, and in addition, for the last several months he has also been instructing a group of about 20 parishioners in **Living in the Divine Will based upon the writings of Servant of God Luisa Piccarreta in Book of Heaven**. The classes, which meet at St. John's school on Thursday afternoons from 4 p.m. to 5:30 p.m., have gone so well that Father Luke is extending an invitation to expand the classes to all who are interested.

The Servant of God Luisa Piccarreta is a Church-approved mystic with Church-approved private revelations whose works have received dozens of ecclesiastical approbations, including 19 imprimaturs and she was declared a Servant of God in the 1990s. **In August of 2024 the Vatican announced it had given its own direct approval of Luisa's cause for Beatification and Canonization, and that the Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith had given her the Nihil Obstat.**

"Thy Will be done on earth as it is in Heaven." Jesus told Luisa Piccarreta that within these eleven words is found everything He taught her about "Living in the Divine Will." As Daniel O'Connor states in his book, *An Introduction To Living in the Divine Will - 33 Lessons From Luisa Piccarreta*; if you're a very busy person who currently has only 30 extra seconds free to spare each day, living in the Divine Will is for you. If you're a retiree eager to find a new mission that will more than fill each of your remaining days, living in the Divine Will is also for you. The book we will be using is: **"An Introduction to Living In The Divine Will -- 33 Lessons from Luisa Piccarreta"** by Daniel O'Connor. It is available on Amazon for \$8. 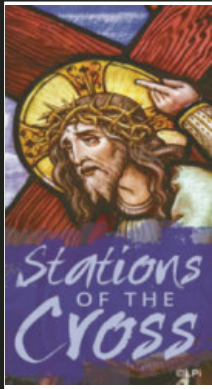
