

# MITCH'S MESSAGE

At one point in my life, I didn't live with my father. He was a drill sergeant in the military and brought a lot of that "strictness" home. Eventually, my parents got a divorce due to a few poor decisions from my dad. I remember him being loving, but very calloused to what was happening to our family. I knew he was in the wrong, but I still loved him.



When we lived in the Philippines and my dad was here in the U.S., I remember sitting in the car with my mom and brother while they argued and yelled at each other. I noticed my brother's attitude toward everything was changing...for the worse. It was at that moment that I called my dad from the Philippines to ask for his help. Deep down, I wanted to know he was still in my life and could fix things.

Months later, he surprised us with a visit to the Philippines. We still have a picture of me hugging him, happy and crying at the same time. I knew full well the pain and the hurt he has caused our entire family. I heard all the negative things said about him by his own sisters and my mom's brother. But at that moment, I didn't care. He was there. It was only by the grace of God that, not only was he there to see his sons, but also to win back his bride.



You see, after realizing the need for change in his life, he turned to Christ, who alone gave him the resolve to become the husband and father he was called to be. My father turned away from his old life and prayed and fought to win his family back. He did that and more. Not only was he there and present, but he also led all of us closer to Christ. Ironically, despite every fault and failure from my dad's past, he is the reason for the faith that I have. He has also become a role model for my own marriage with Rebecca. When I think of him, I think of what St. Paul calls all husbands to do: "to love your wives like Christ loved the Church and gave Himself up for her." It's an honor to witness my dad do that every day for my mom.

Fathers, our sons and daughters are watching how we love our wives, how we love them, and how we love Christ. I know it's not always easy to be a father, especially for some of us growing up with poor examples of fatherhood. The good news is that we have St. Joseph as a model and our Father in heaven as the source of all fatherhood. Our past does not define our future.

Fathers, you are all incredible gifts to your families. God chose you, not because you're the perfect father but because He knows what you're capable of being. Thank you for being a rock and a shield. Thank you for your selflessness and courage. And thank you, Father in heaven, for giving us these fathers as earthly images of your loving fatherhood for all of us. Amen.






## LOW GLUTEN HOSTS

Do you know that we have a supply of low-gluten hosts for anyone unable to receive Eucharist because of gluten intolerance? The bread is made by the Benedictine Sisters of Clyde, Missouri, and has a gluten content of less than .001%, or 10ppm, and is approved by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. If you wish to use this bread, here is the procedure:



- Before Mass, enter the priest's vesting room in the Gathering Space. You will find two containers, one for the host; the other for the pyx (as shown above right).
- Place one host in a pyx, close it, and place the pyx on the altar before Mass.
- During the communion procession, ask the extraordinary minister to give you the pyx from the altar. You open the pyx and receive the Eucharist. (This is to eliminate cross-contamination from the regular hosts.)
- Keep the pyx and return it to the glass case in the vesting room after Mass.




