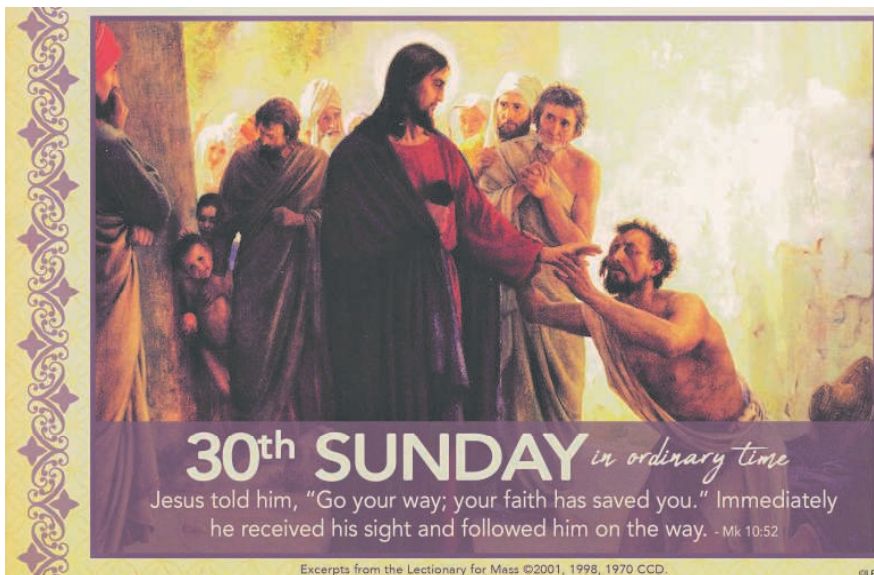

## From Father Steve's Desk

### Scripture Reflection

The Gospel today gives us the encounter of Jesus and a blind man named Bartimaeus. When Jesus calls out for him, he comes immediately. Jesus asks what Bartimaeus desires. He replies that he wants to see. Jesus simply declares that Bartimaeus' faith has healed him. Bartimaeus regains his sight and follows Jesus "on the way." In other words he has been called by Jesus to be a disciple. Even though Bartimaeus had been physically blind he could already see with the eyes of faith. That is how Bartimaeus recognizes the power of Jesus and why he responded the way he did. "I was blind, but now I see."

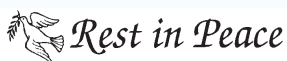
