Scripture Reflection

Whenever Jesus sees something unfair or unjust, he will confront it with strong criticism. Jesus could be particularly critical of the religious leaders, (scribes and pharisees). In the Gospel today, he confronts the scribes. The scribes were very self-absorbed. In reality, they were far removed from ordinary people.

The second part of the Gospel was about the contribution of a poor widow. Jesus watches as some put large sums of money into the temple treasury. He is especially taken by a widow who is only able to contribute the equivalent of a few cents. She gave all she had.

This gospel isn't really about money at all. It's about the level of commitment to the Lord. The poor widow was totally committed.
