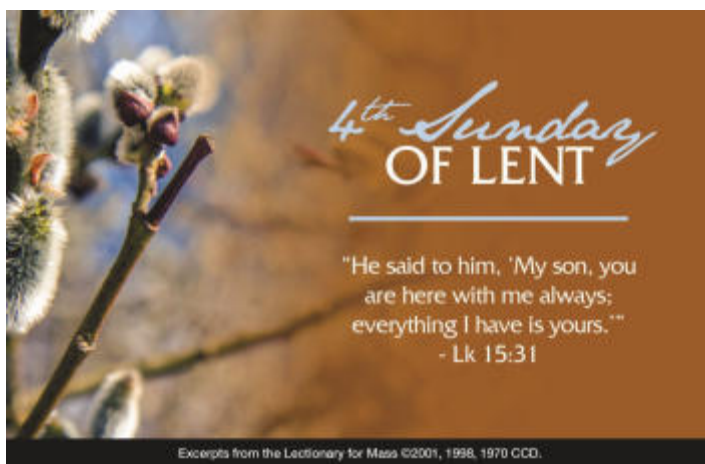

Scripture Reflection

The Gospel of Luke presents God's mercy as something that cannot be earned or deserved. It is given freely as grace.
