Scripture Reflection

The parable presented in the Gospel describes a man who had become rich. His harvest was so large that there wasn't enough room to store it all. He decides to build bigger barns to store all his grain. He thought that bigger barns with more grain would provide more security in the future.

The parable is suggesting that the man had failed to see the role God plays in his life. The wealthy man was thinking only of himself. He gave no consideration to sharing a portion to help others. Jesus is telling us that true wealth can be found in what matters to God. People are more important than "things".
