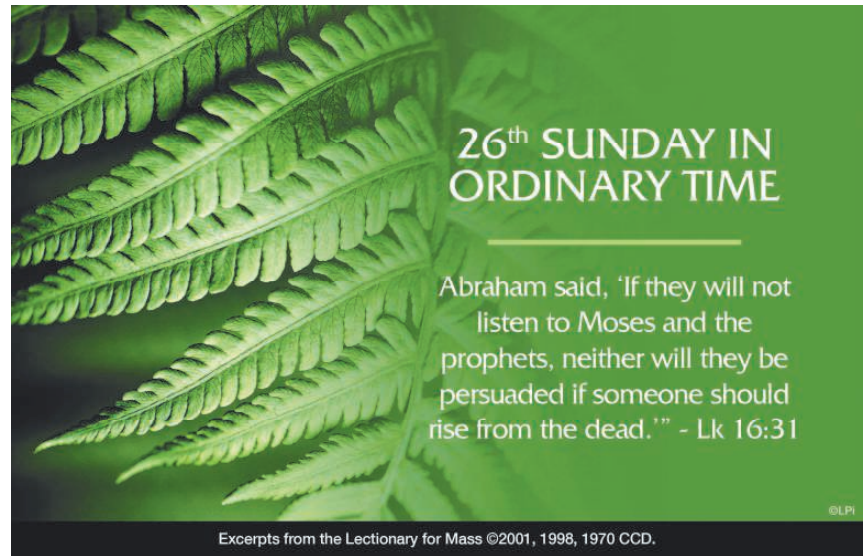

### Scripture Reflection

The roles are reversed when the rich man and Lazarus die. The rich man wants Lazarus to send his (rich man) brothers a warning about using possessions wisely.
