Scripture Reflection

Jesus makes it clear that faith is not about quantity. Faith demands trust and commitment toward God. The point Jesus is making is that the tiniest amount of faith is very powerful. It isn't a matter of needing more faith. It is a matter of using what we have.

The parable Jesus tells describes a situation where a servant does what he is expected to do and he gets no special recognition for it. Jesus wants his disciples to understand that everything they do is done with God's help. Whenever we engage in works of charity or mercy we are doing so as instruments of God's love.
