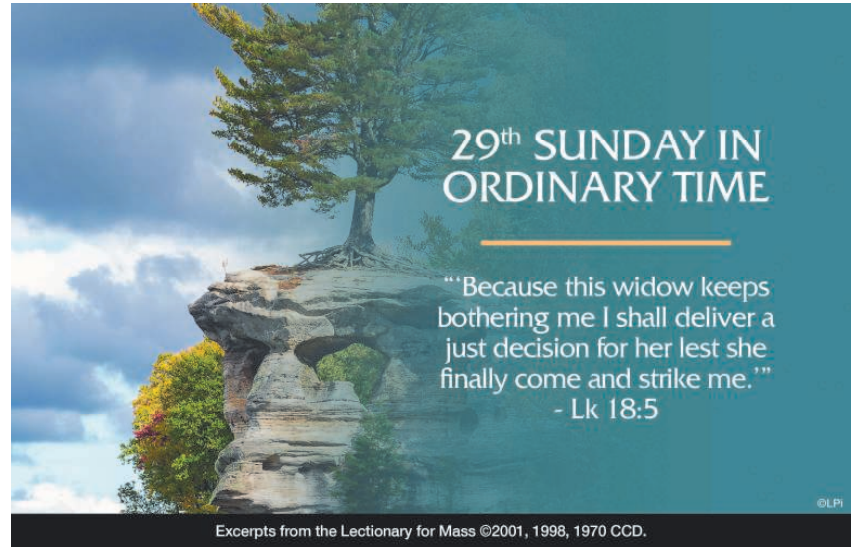

Scripture Reflection

In the Gospel today we hear the parable of the widow and the judge. The parable deals with persistence in prayer. Widows were among the most unprotected people in Jesus' time. They had to rely on judges to protect them and give them at least a little justice. The widow is seeking justice from an unjust judge. She isn't letting him deter her. Eventually, it is her persistence that forces the judge to give her a just decision.

In this parable, the judge doesn't represent God. The focus is the widows persistence. With prayer the God of mercy and generosity is strengthened. We must never give up on the power of prayer. Prayer is actually an act of faith and love. We must never give up on the Lord who always hears the prayers from a humble heart.

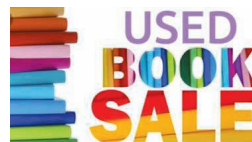
