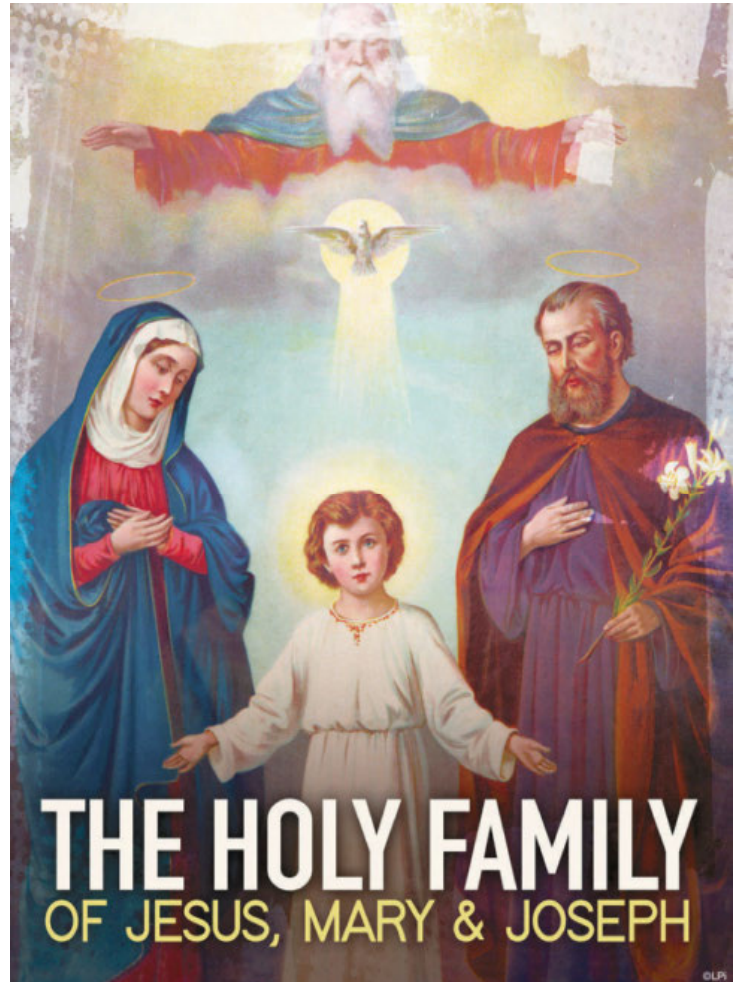

This means that shipping boxes can be recycled, but padded envelopes or pouches cannot because they contain more than one material.
