

The Epiphany of the Lord

"And on entering the house they found Jesus with his mother, Mary. They prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their coffers and presented him with gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh" (Mt. 2:11).

Today the Church celebrates the Epiphany of the Lord. We normally associate Epiphany with the visit of the Magi, but that would only be part of the significance. The word epiphany means "to show" or "to reveal". In the epiphany the identity of Jesus is being revealed. He is truly the infleshment of love of God. The Magi are transformed by their encounter with Jesus. We also offer gifts to the Lord; not gold, frankincense and myrrh, but our love, devotion, and commitment.




Couples preparing for the Baptism of their first child are to participate in the Baptism I program. The date of the classes for 2022 are...



HAITI CONNECTION

As we are aware the rectory and church of St. Montfort in Port de Paix, Haiti, have been broken into, property stolen, and tabernacle desecrated. In late October Fr. Rebert was able to have the windows and doors of the rectory secured with bars. He also hired a security guard. The Haiti Committee is pursuing further efforts to secure the parish grounds and buildings. Currently we are applying for a grant from the BVM community for monitors (cameras). There is a guard employed by the parish who would monitor those cameras. Also a security application will be put on Fr. Rebert's phone.

In addition Fr. Rebert requests that any extra money from this grant be applied to the dispensary. With the current crisis in Haiti more and more people are unable to pay for drugs and for help for malnourished children whose mothers come seeking assistance.

Times continue to be very serious and life is full of danger for our friends at St. Montfort parish. Please continue to pray for them.
