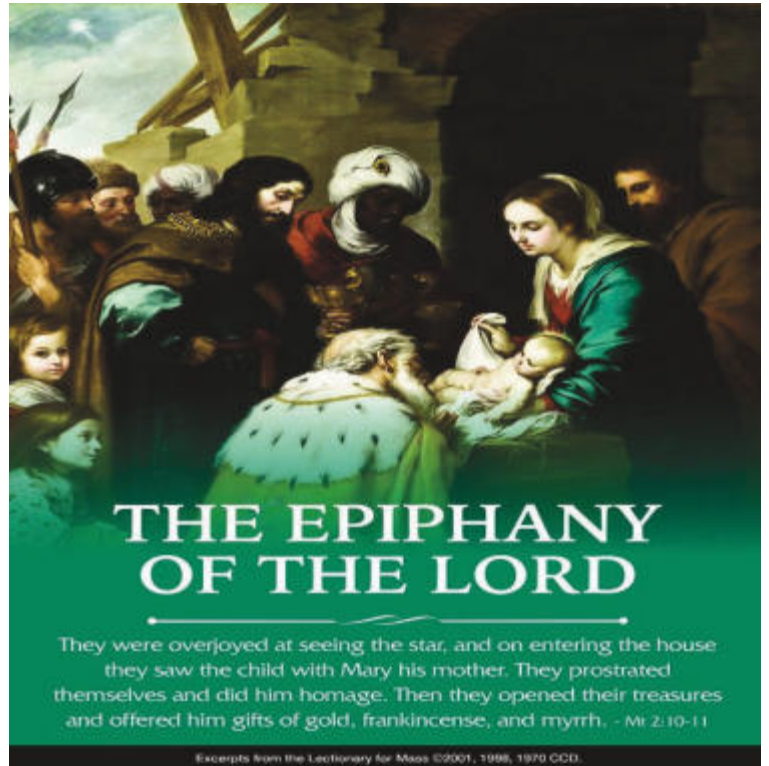

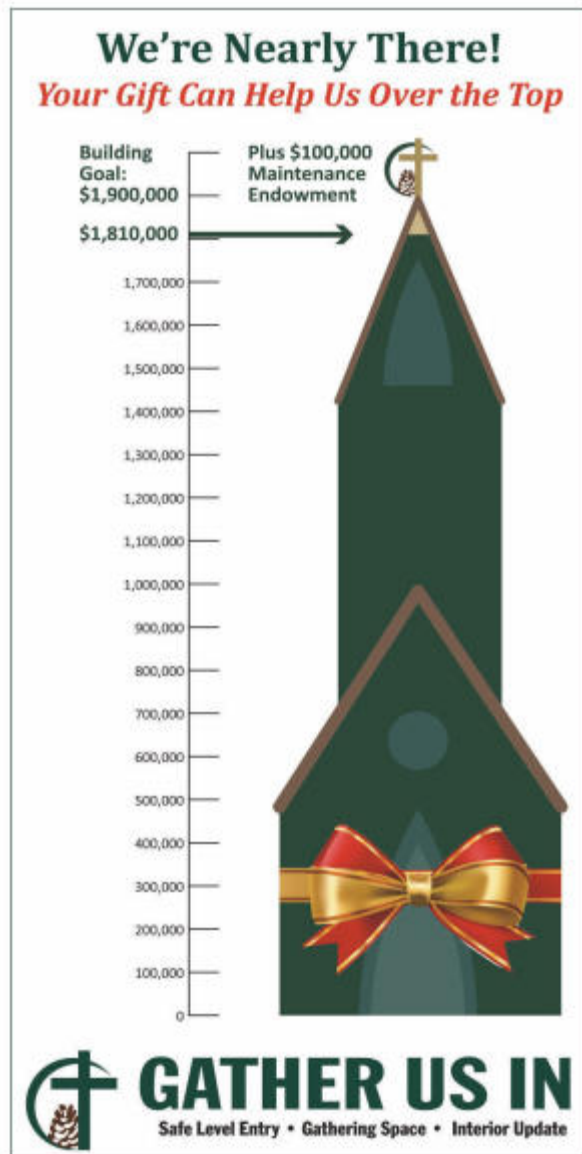


Thanks be to God! **Our response continues to grow! To date we have received 82 *Gather Us In* commitments totaling \$1,814,882.** The generous response of our parishioners and friends to our *Gather Us In* campaign is a true blessing.

Did you know that the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act provides increased tax incentives for charitable giving? The window for taking advantage of these changes closes on **December 31, 2020.**

For those donors who itemize their deductions, and therefore directly write off gifts to charity, the deduction cap has been raised to 100% of adjusted gross income (earlier cap was 60%).

For people who no longer itemize their charitable giving, the CARES Act will allow these individual taxpayers to deduct donations to charity of up to \$300 on their 2020 federal tax return, even though they take the standard deduction. Married-filing-jointly taxpayers will get an above-the-line deduction of up to \$300.

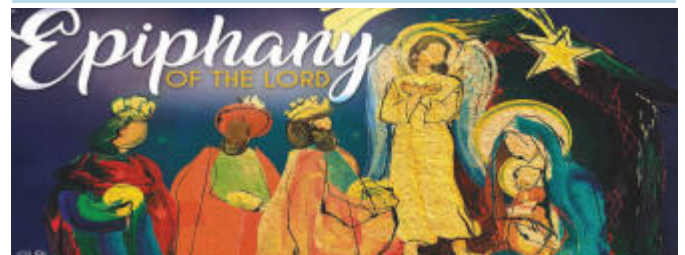
