We're very nearly there!

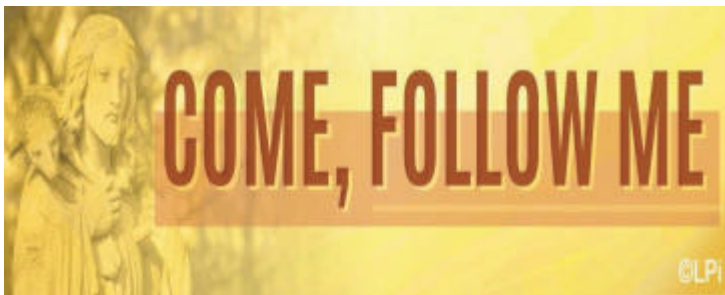
How grateful we are to those who've seen the good in our project and have stepped forward to support it. A safe level entry will surely help our elderly brothers and sisters come to church during winters.

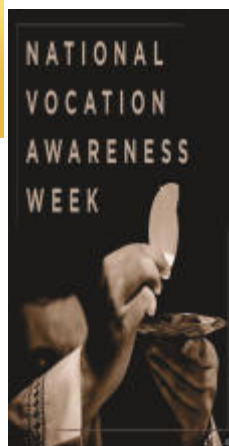

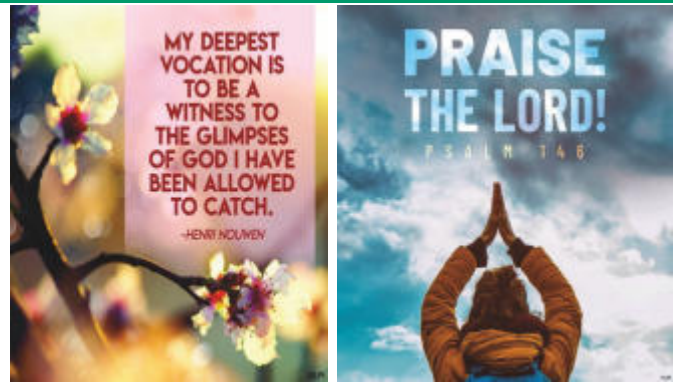
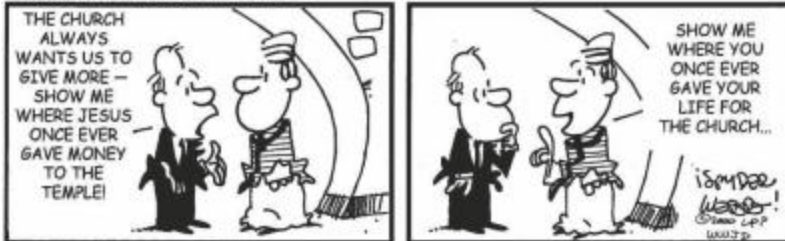

Using scientific studies, Vicki Thorn shows how men and women are inherently different, yet are built to complement each other.
