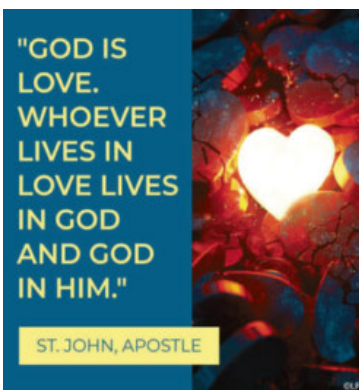
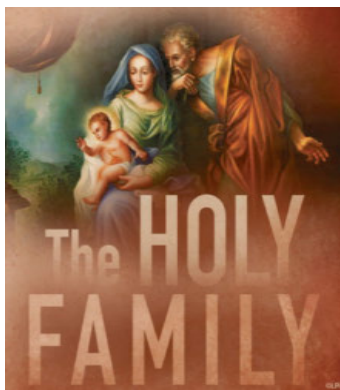
We want to thank everyone for their prayers, for the leadership that made this campaign possible, and for the generous financial support of this parish and those beyond St. Anne's.

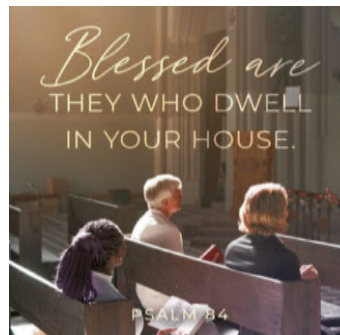

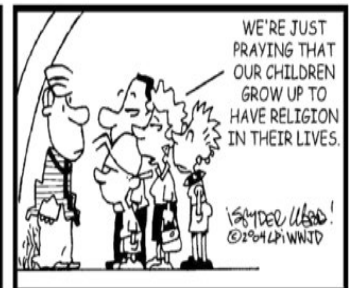
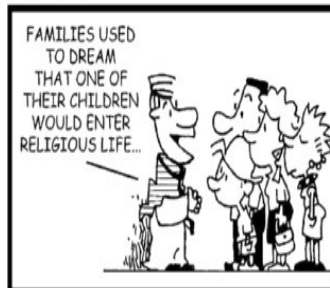
