### Fr. Glenn's Pen

We find ourselves in Ordinary Time, when the Church simply counts the Sundays in order when outside the seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent and Easter. The Church systematically walks us through the Scriptures. Last year we focused on Mark's gospel and this year we turn towards Luke's gospel. Today however we hear the story of Jesus' first public miracle at the Wedding in Cana found in John's gospel. Next week we start working our way through Luke's gospel.

In the first reading we hear Isaiah's message of hope and how Jerusalem will be central to God's plan for humanity. The Psalmist invites us to have God's song in our heart! God blesses us so much! Like little children who have no concept of their parents love and sacrifice for them, we are not really aware of what God does for us and generally are usually are not very effusive in our praise of Him.

Catholics may be aware of Charismatic Christian groups who relish in the gifs of the Spirt that Paul recounts to the Corinthians. Many Catholics may not be aware of these gifts being manifested in many Catholic Charismatic prayer groups and meetings today. These miracles do happen now and many people speak in tongues and these are indeed gifts. Paul makes it clear that these gifts are freely give to others from the Spirit, he goes on to say that the greatest gift is love. I believe it was Pope Leo the Great who said something to the effect, "You know you are a real Christian when you show more concern over the person's soul who may have wronged you or hurt you in some way!"

This first public miracle at the wedding of Cana is a beautiful image of God's concern for us even in life's every day moments. Wedding celebrations would often last several days, so that accounts for the large quantities of wine. Jesus' wine is superior. If only we allow Jesus to act in our lives we too will experience wonderful things that are far superior to the world. Lent begins March 2 this year. May we journey towards Lent with the expectation of drawing closer to Christ! Remember the Church does not exist to change the world, it is God's gift to the world to change us. Be open to the grace God longs to give you! Don't be afraid to be changed, so that you can really affect the world around you!
