October is Respect Life month in the Church, but January is another month wherein we focus on the issue of life from conception. January 22 is the anniversary of the Roe v Wade and Doe v Bolton companion decisions in the Supreme Court that legalized abortion in the United States. We mourn this decision as every life from conception to natural death is precious in God's eyes. *(Before I formed you in the womb I knew you-Jeremiah 1:5)* This decision has ended the lives of millions of children and the lives of millions more mothers, fathers and families have been tragically impacted.

This last December 1, the Supreme Court heard oral arguments in the Dobbs v Jackson Women's Health Organization. This case is one that focuses on the right of a state to set limits on abortion before viability. (*To learn more, please see this week's bulletin insert*) Now more than ever, prayer is needed for hearts to be open to understand the gift of human life. Now more than ever we need to support those who don't feel they have much of a "choice" when they find unexpectedly that they are pregnant.

As a parish, there are several ways that we wish to help you focus on this during the month of January and beyond.

- For those who have been affected by abortion, the Church holds out it's healing love especially through Project Rachel. Confidential help after abortion is available by calling 812-483-7812 or by emailing projectrachel@evdio.org

- As we pack up our Christmas church decor for another year, we are going to leave the Holy Family figures out to remind us to pray especially for the Dobbs case until the opinion of the court is delivered in June.

- As the anniversary of the Roe v Wade decision nears, the United States Catholic Conference of Bishops invites us to join specifically in nine days of prayer from January 19th through the 27th. You can find a shortened, hard-copy version of the novena in the narthex. You can sign up for a daily text, email or find the novena complete with daily intention, prayer, reflection and acts of reparation by visiting www.9daysforlife.com

- We will email out the videos on Life Issues produced by the diocese during the 9 days of prayer. These short videos on many issues of life are usually shown during the diocesan pilgrimage for life.

- As the diocese will not be holding its pilgrimage for life due to COVID precautions, the annual send off Mass at Ferdinand will not be held. Instead, there will be a Mass for Life followed by Holy Hour Vigil all starting at 5:30 pm on Friday, January 21 at St. Benedict Cathedral.

Brothers and sisters, let us continue to stand for life, especially for those lives that aren't given a voice. May our love for all peoples born and unborn change the hearts of all peoples in our land.

Please note: The drive will only last for 6 weeks this year from December 18, 2021 to January 30, 2022.




