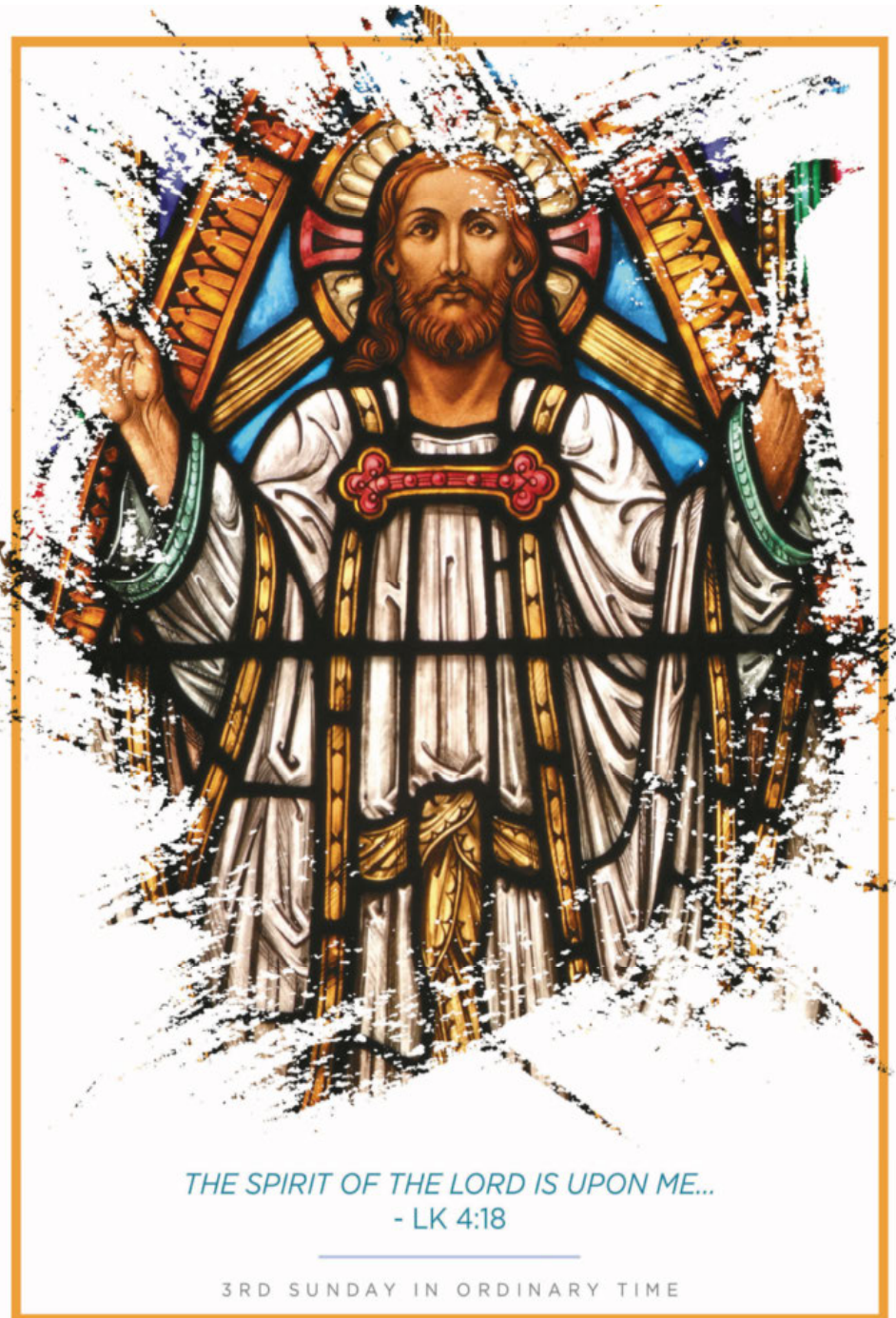

If you don't already, or would like to have the opportunity to do more of that, please take advantage of the many adult faith formation opportunities that we have going on here at Holy Redeemer. We also have those opportunities for our young people through our High School and Junior High youth ministries.

There is no test to see how much you know before you arrive or after the formation opportunity concludes. It takes just a little openness to know that you won't know it all, but that what you share in your understanding and experiences may well help someone else as well. Please prayerfully consider taking part in these opportunities. If our faith isn't growing, it's declining. We can't just stand still.
