



the presentations. It was a wonderful witness to see so many people connected outside just our own parish family. People knew each other from work, from other prayer groups they are involved in, through the Cursillo, Teens Encounter Christ and Communion & Liberation movements to name a few. It is wonderful any time people can gather together to share their faith as well as to grow in.

I pray that you take those opportunities to share your faith and grow in it as well. If you don't already, or would like to have the opportunity to do more of that, please take advantage of the many adult faith formation opportunities that we have going on here at Holy Redeemer. There are a number of groups that have just started and Wednesdays at the Well will begin in earnest in February. We also have those opportunities for our young people through our High School and Junior High youth ministries.

Unfortunately there is at times the worry that a person doesn't *know* enough to join these offerings. This is not the case at all. Sure, people are at different places in their own faith, but it is about learning, sharing and growing together. It is the devil who gives that excuse to keep you from coming. There is no test to see how much you know before you arrive or after the formation opportunity concludes. It takes just a little openness to know that you won't know it all, but that what you share in your understanding and experiences may well help someone else as well. Please prayerfully consider taking part in these opportunities. If our faith isn't growing, it's declining. We can't just stand still.






Wednesdays at the Well Resumes February 2nd
