

Thank you to all of those who visited the new youth room for the open house and blessing last Sunday. We are truly grateful to have this beautiful space. Mary Jo has already seen the wonderful dynamics of how youth physically moving from the tables in one area to the prayer area moves them mentally to be open to receiving, sharing and going deeper. The warming kitchen has been great to create the delectable goodies for morning Cafe Cristo that fill the stomachs of 30+ junior high students as their souls are being filled as well. It has been a long time in the needing as far as space for our numbers and long enough in the coming as construction always takes longer than expected.

The most important piece though is the hand-carved, olive wood crucifix from Bethlehem that is the focal point. Made even more special was that it came to us custom-made through the Holy Land Arts group that regularly visits the parish with their olive wood pieces of art sold to support the Holy Land. As special as those details are though, Mary Jo reminded those at the blessing on Sunday that "Christ is the center of our ministry here, so it is only appropriate that we have the beautiful crucifix as the focal point and first thing that greets people as they come through the door."
