

Dear Holy Redeemer Parishioners,

I am excited to provide you with an update on our strategic planning process. You may recall this process began in February with a listening phase that included a survey to parishioners and in person meetings to help inform our planning. Based on this input, we developed four focus areas:

1) <u>Communication</u>: Communication was regularly mentioned on the survey and at the listening sessions. We will be forming a communication committee to review how we communicate as a parish and identify ways to better inform the parish and external community.



- 2) <u>Parish-School Connection</u>: Our school is growing, and we want to foster a strong connection between the parish and school. Parishioners can be better informed about the school, and school families can be better connected to the parish. The Parish Council and School Commission will work collaboratively on this effort.
- 3) <u>Facilities</u>: Although we are blessed with great facilities, we need to develop a long-term plan for maintenance and repairs. In addition, we would like to prioritize facility needs to also include new projects. There were several comments from parishioners about beautifying the church, and we will be looking at opportunities to do this. Recall that funds from the diocesan Stewards of God's Grace campaign have already been allocated to replacing flooring and pew reupholstering.
- 4) <u>Engagement</u>: The pandemic has resulted in decreased connection to the parish and with one another, and we think there is an opportunity to better connect our parishioners' gifts and talents to ministries they may feel called to participate in. An engagement committee will be developed to guide this work.

We see this plan as an opportunity for our Holy Redeemer Parish Family to more fully build God's kingdom. To achieve this vision, we need you to be involved. How can you help in this effort? If you are interested in getting involved, please let me know. As Tad Dickel has continued to remind us during this process, creating the strategic plan is the easy part. Implementing it takes much more work. Please help us with this work over the next three years by giving of your time and talent as well as by your prayers.

I would like to thank the planning team members for their help throughout this process: Tad Dickel, Nathan Hassler, Joe Kelley, Stephanie Richard, Jeff Wilmes, Becky York, and Jessica Zellers. They have met regularly this spring and have provided valuable assistance as we plan for the future of Holy Redeemer.
