

New Parish Directory

Do you ever leave church and think, "It was so nice chatting with them after mass today. I wish I could remember their name." Would you like to send a sympathy card but don't know a parishioner's current address? Do you love looking back at old photos with your children and grandchildren? An updated pictorial directory would help you with all this.



As Fr. Jason mentioned at masses last weekend, Holy Redeemer is working on an updated pictorial directory. A letter was mailed out this past week with more information on setting up a picture

appointment and a form to update contact information for you and your family. We invite you to schedule your appointment for the photo shoot to make our directory a success. Bennett Photography will be here Saturday, July 23 through Sunday, July 31 to take pictures. You can schedule your appointment online using the link on our parish website, after weekend masses in the Narthex at the computer stations with representatives to assist you, or you may call or visit the Parish Office during the week. Photo sessions will only take about 10-15 minutes. Pictures will be available online approximately 36 hours after they are taken in order to select the one you would like to be in the directory. You may also purchase photos online, but it is not necessary or required. (The Parish Office will be available to assist you with selecting your directory photo and purchasing any pictures if you do not have access to a computer.) This online component with the photographer will help to avoid the high-pressure purchase situations of previous pictorial directories.

To make our parish pictorial directory as useful as possible, we also need to update parishioner contact information for it. In order for this information to be as current as possible, we ask you to take the time to update your own personal information. For those who have an email on file in our parish data system, we will be sending you a link soon to register in a new Parish Life program to update your contact information. If you do not have an email address on file in our system, please fill out the enclosed Important Information form and return to the Parish Office or place in the Sunday Collection basket as soon as possible. A completed census form is requested in order to be included in our parish directory.

If you have moved to another parish or no longer wish to remain on our parish mailing list as a parishioner, please call the Parish Office at 812-424-8344.

Thank you for your assistance in keeping our records current and for helping to create a fantastic parish pictorial directory. Please do not hesitate to call the parish office if you have any questions.


