Last weekend we had our Eucharistic procession on the Solemnity of Corpus Christi or the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Seeing those processing with us as well as hearing the sung responses in honor of our Lord was beautiful. God gave us wonderful weather and the great rosary path to process around the entirety of our parish property. I'm sorry that not everyone was able to join us for the procession but we plan to celebrate the Solemnity again next year in the same way.

As we continue our time of Eucharistic renewal, I want to send out this invitation to join us. If you have been away because of COVID concerns, have been gone longer than that or have simply fallen out of the practice of regularly joining us at Mass each weekend, I invite you to come back. None of us was designed to be separated from one another. This community of faith and love is incredible. There is a reason that I regularly call it our Parish Family. I know a number of people who have been through difficult times that continue to tell me that they don't know what they would do without our Parish Family.

This community is one thing, but the reason we gather is quite another. To be able to receive the true Body and Blood of Jesus is incredible. It is sustenance for the journey of our daily life. It is the strength that is needed to endure the difficult trials and uncertainties that are a part of our journey through life.

When you are not here, God desires even more to feed you with the very Body and Blood of His Son. Deacon Kevin reminded us of this great gift last weekend in the homily. We and God not only desire you to be here with us, we desire your family, friends, neighbors, coworkers and others to be here with us too. Take a moment to formulate in your own mind why being at Mass makes a difference to you. Scripture tells, "always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you for a reason for your hope." (1 Pet 3:15) In the same way explain to others why you come to Mass. It is incumbent on each of us to invite others to come back or come and join us for the first time. Why would we not want others to encounter the same Lord and community as we find when we join together each weekend. Let us during this Eucharistic renewal be reminded of why we come and why we need to re-invite others to join us as well.
