Theology of the Body Conference at Holy Redeemer July 29th-31st

Between 1978 and 1984, Pope St. John Paul II delivered a series of Wednesday audiences that eventually became known as the Theology of the Body. This profound teaching offered what St. John Paul called an "adequate anthropology"—an examination of what it means to be human, made in God's image and likeness, and how that reality is made visible in our human bodies. Last weekend we began displaying the Eucharistic Miracles exhibit in the narthex of the church. It is one of the Diocese of Evansville's initiatives for the Eucharist Renewal. There are seven traveling Eucharistic Miracle exhibits in total. This initiative began on Corpus Christi, June 19, 2022 and will continue until Corpus Christi, June 11, 2023. They will periodically be present at every parish, Catholic school, the Catholic Center and Catholic Charities. We have this particular set of Eucharistic Miracles exhibit until July 12 when we will pass it along to the Catholic Center. We will have other unique sets come to the parish and school for exhibition in October, December, February, April & June. We will remind you in advance when the exhibits arrive. We invite you

and your family to come visit the Eucharistic Miracles exhibit each time. Bring neighbors and others to learn more about these incredible instances of God reminding us of the Real Presence of His Son Jesus in the Eucharist.

The Eucharistic Miracles project itself began with Blessed Carlo Acutis. He is a young man from Italy who was just declared Blessed on October 10, 2020 in Assisi. He died from Leukemia in 2006 at the early age of fifteen. His parents were not particularly devout, but he had a special love for God from an early age. After making his First Holy Communion he went to Mass as often as he could, making a holy hour before or after Mass. He prayed the rosary and went to confession weekly. He begged his parents to take him to the places of the saints and the sites of Eucharistic miracles. His devotion to the faith led to a deep conversion of his mother. It was he who was bringing his parents and relatives to Mass more frequently. He was a normal teenager who loved playing video games and computer programming. He even built a website promoting and cataloguing the Eucharistic miracles he learned about, so great was his desire to share them with others.

It is from this website project that we have the Eucharistic Miracles exhibit in our parish and in the Diocese. If it might be easier for you to view the panels at home on your computer rather than in the narthex, please follow the link on the parish website. Also feel free to visit it to learn more about the Eucharistic Miracles. They are another way that God is making known to us more clearly that Jesus is really and truly present in His Body and Blood in the Eucharist. May the faith of this young man continue to inspire us and many others to believe more deeply in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ. God Bless, Fr. Jason Gries.
