



Theology of the Body Conference at Holy Redeemer July 29th-31st

Between 1978 and 1984, Pope St. John Paul II delivered a series of Wednesday audiences that eventually became known as the Theology of the Body. This profound teaching offered what St. John Paul called an "adequate anthropology"—an examination of what it means to be human, made in God's image and likeness, and how that reality is made visible in our human bodies. A Note from Fr. Jason ~ Sunday, July 17, 2022 • 6



Welcome to Sr. Irma Arnold, O.S.F. who is with us this weekend as a part of our Diocesan Mission Co-Op. She is a member of the Franciscan Sisters of Oldenburg, Indiana. She has been a teacher for over 50 years and is currently teaching at St. James school in Haubstadt. Her biological sister, Sr. Bridget Arnold, O.S.F., is also a religious sister with the Franciscan Sisters of Oldenburg, Indiana. Sr. Bridget began teaching at St. Joe (Vanderburgh County) while I was in school there and continues to teach there now.

There are many mission groups that come asking for the opportunity to speak to our local parish communities and ask for support. The Diocese has created a clearing

house of sorts in our annual Mission Co-Op. This helps these groups so that it is fair and equitable for them as well as to the parishes. Every year the Diocese decides on twelve groups to have the opportunity to make a mission appeal. Each group is assigned to a cluster of several local parishes to do their appeal at some point during the year. This year we have been paired with St. Joe (Vanderburgh County); Corpus Christi; St. Philip, Mt. Vernon and St. Mathew, Mt. Vernon. On one side this process makes sure that every group is able to receive sufficient support whether they are able to be in larger parishes or smaller parishes which may affect their efforts at raising funds. The parish clusters have been determined to create an equitable distribution of funds based on recent history of support by the parishes with visiting missionaries. On the other side it ensures that parishes are not bombarded by requests for mission appeals and makes sure that they are legitimate organizations. It is certainly not a perfect system but one that I think has served well the parishes and the organizations too.

I know that you will be open to Sr. Irma as she shares the stories of her order's ministry and outreach. Please be generous in supporting them as well. If you forget or aren't able to give over the weekend, please drop off any gifts to the parish office this week.
