



implementation of the Gabriel Project. The Gabriel Project® offers hope and assistance to any woman experiencing a crisis pregnancy,





So what's going on with this "Pick-Up Choir" thing?

I've stolen the name "pick-up choir" from a music ministry friend. This is how she de-

"Have you ever been part of a basketball league where you were put on a team, and given a schedule to play with that team for a whole year? Then, have you ever been to the park for a pick-up game? In that case, everyone meets in the park on Saturday at 10am, we see who comes, divide into teams and just play."

While there are definitely pros and cons to both ways of doing things, here are some of the pros I see for our Holy Redeemer community to have a pick-up choir in this season:

- -More family friendly both parents and kids are typically busy in the evenings and unable to attend a weekly evening rehearsal.
- -A chance to grow numbers back- the lower commitment barrier allows more people to try choir, which gives us a chance to grow our numbers back after the Covid singing break.
- -Open to all levels- going back to our sports analogy, leagues are often divided by age or ability. Pick up games are going to be a more broad range of ages and skill. As long as you plan ahead for that, it really isn't a problem it's simply a different way of doing things. This pick-up model will allow room in the choir for beginners, professionals and everyone in between.






