

A Note from Fr. Jason ~ Sunday, August 14, 2022 • 6

I will be gone on vacation this next week to Spring Mill state park. I'll be staying at the Inn there. As much as the Boy Scout in me still loves being outdoors, the older man in me loves having a mattress, shower and even an occasional dinner at a restaurant. Fr. Ray Brenner will be at Masses the weekend of August 20/21 in my absence.



It is the time of year again when we begin to consider nominations for the Brute Society. The Bruté Society is an honorary association of southwestern Indiana Catholic lay persons who have been recognized by their fellow parishioners as outstanding models of Christian stewardship. The Bruté Society was established in 1990 as an official activity of the Diocese of Evansville, Indiana. The Bruté Society is named for Servant of God Bishop Simon Bruté who was appointed the first bishop of Vincennes in 1834. At that time, the territory of the Vincennes Diocese included all of

Indiana as well as about one third of Illinois. The name "The Bruté Society" represents the rich spiritual and historical heritage of the present Diocese of Evansville.

Nominees should possess a lifestyle that is in harmony with the teachings of the Catholic faith, an exceptional commitment to the principles of good stewardship usually shown over a period of time through selfless giving of time, talent, and/or treasure to the life and work of a parish. Ultimately, these are individuals or couples whom fellow parishioners would be proud to have represent their parish by being accepted as members of The Bruté Society.

As a special symbol of membership in The Bruté Society, each member receives a beautiful, distinctive medallion known as the "Simon Bruté Medal." The ribbon from which this medal hangs is placed around the neck of new members by the bishop as part of the induction ceremony. The medal was fashioned from the official diocesan stewardship logo. This logo depicts the three



stewardship "Ts" (Treasure, Time and Talent) presented in a way that looks like three people arrayed in a triangle. At the center stands the powerful symbol of the cross representing the core of the Christian Faith.

Every year, the parish of Holy Redeemer is able to recognize several parishioners by induction into to the Bruté Society. Nominations are sought and past inductees from the parish gather to prayerfully discern who to recognize. Nominations can be made by visiting the parish website or by finding a form in the narthex of the church. With the size of our parish family, we are able to recognize 2 individuals or couples. Please make sure to turn in your nomination by August 29.


