

### LENTEN DISCIPLINES OF FASTING & ABSTINENCE

Fasting consists of eating only one meal, with the possibility of two smaller snacks that do not add up to a single full meal.

Catholics age 14 and older are to abstain from meat on all Fridays in Lent.



Hello Holy Redeemer Family,

Being a part of Spiritual Life & Worship Committee has become a springboard to cultivate my Catholic faith. While taking part in liturgy changeover, I've been learning more about the feasts & seasons. The Church calendar isn't ordinary by any stretch of the imagination. Liturgical Living is an intentional way as the Body of Christ to live out our Catholic culture.

I grew up in a practicing Catholic home and as an adult, I am grateful for it. I wasn't always a willing participant and at times thought praying the family rosary was a form of torture, not a way to grow in holiness. It was hard to wrap my head and heart around walking with Jesus, but a faithful foundation was being poured out and the framework had already started before I knew it.

Around late June 2024, a prayer of sorts was laid on my heart. "It's summertime, the sun is out and shining. How do I keep the light burning within when it's cold and dark, Lord?" A spark was ignited and a zest for Jesus Christ. Liturgical Living was the answer. I bet many of you are already living this way and didn't know it. Invite others into your feasting and fasting season. We're not meant to do this alone.

Our saintly friend, St John the Baptist had me in his line of vision. "He must increase; I must decrease." John 3:30. Holy Mother Church in her wisdom knew the days would shorten following the summer solstice. Around this time is the Nativity of John the Baptist, on June 24th. Then I remembered that Jesus & John the Baptist births are six months apart. During Advent we're preparing for the birth of Christ and His second coming. Winter solstice is a few days before Christmas and in the Northern Hemisphere we're gaining more time of daylight.

Our Catholicity can be incorporated into the hum drum of everyday life. For me, the key is to plan ahead with upcoming feast days, especially when preparing festive dishes. You can include wearing the liturgical colors when attending Mass. They can be found on our Holy Redeemer Calendar or on the USCCB website. Recently someone at work asked me if I was wearing red for the Kansas Chiefs with the upcoming Super Bowl. I said, "No, I'm wearing it for the martyrs feast day." It was awkward yes, but a way to be a witness.

I'm still finding and learning ways to celebrate the traditions & feasts of the Church. I'll share with you some of the things I did for previous feast days. For the Epiphany, I baked an angel food cake. Umm, let's just say the angel lost one of its' wings and fell on the counter. Next up, I combined the feast of St Andrew and the beginning of Advent. I made an Italian Wedding Soup from scratch. It was a long day in the kitchen but completely worth it. Lastly, I got around to baking a Pistachio Bundt Cake for the feast of the Presentation and of St Bridget.

If your feeling green in liturgical living, don't worry. There's lots of different aesthetics and formats to choose from. You can incorporate your own gifts and talents. Like using woodworking skills in honor of St Joseph or adding a saint's intercessory prayer on their feast day to your prayer time. John the Baptist is continually pointing me to Christ Jesus and reminding me to take time with the Lord of Hosts.

Fun fact, I just found out St Kateri Tekakwitha is the patron saint of pretzels. The three holes of the pretzels are a reminder of the Holy Trinity: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. In the Middle Ages, monks gave away pretzel as a religious symbol of the Trinity to the poor and to provide nourishment. The saints are more than ordinary.

Here's a handful of resources that have been helpful for me if you'd like to know more about Liturgical Living. With Lent coming up, it's a good time to run a marathon because we fast.
