Safe Environment Program Diocese of Evansville Diocesan Report and Inform Policy

Children are the most important gifts God has entrusted to us. The Diocese of Evansville is committed to safeguarding minors, who are persons under eighteen (18) years of age. Immediately report the suspected abuse or neglect of a minor to the Department of Child Services (DCS) or to a local law enforcement agency.

- State of Indiana DCS Hotline: 1-800-800-5556
- Local law enforcement: 9-1-1

If a bishop has (a) performed sexual acts with a minor or a vulnerable person; (b) forced someone to perform or to submit to sexual acts through violence, threat, or abuse of authority; (c) produced, exhibited, possessed, or distributed child pornography, including by electronic means, or recruited or induced a minor or vulnerable person to participate in pornographic exhibitions; or (d) executed actions or omissions intended to interfere with or avoid a civil or Church (canonical) investigation into allegations of sexual abuse committed by a cleric or religious: after reporting to DCS or to a local law enforcement agency, inform the Catholic Bishop Abuse Reporting service, which is a third-party reporting service for gathering and relaying such reports to the appropriate Church authorities.

- If the sexual abuse of a minor involves a priest, deacon, candidate for ordination, pastoral minister, administrator, staff person, or volunteer: after reporting to DCS or to a local law enforcement agency, inform the diocesan victim assistance coordinator.

The sexual abuse of a minor also includes:

- A vulnerable person is any person in a state of infirmity, physical or mental deficiency, or deprivation of personal liberty which, in fact, even occasionally limits their ability to understand or to want or otherwise resist the offense.
- Child pornography, which is any representation of a minor, regardless of the means used, involved in explicit sexual activities, whether real or simulated, and any representation of sexual organs of minors for primarily sexual purposes.

Gianna Emanuela Molla makes regular appearances in the U.S., speaking at various parishes, universities and special events. Molla is the daughter of St. Gianna Beretta Molla and speaks in order to share her mother's story of self-sacrificing love and help devotion to St. Gianna continue to grow. Molla is the child St. Gianna struggled to carry to term after doctors discovered a fibroid tumor that threatened both her life and her baby's. Doctors gave St. Gianna three choices: a hysterectomy to save her life, but end her baby's; an abortion, followed by surgery; or a risky surgery to remove the fibroid while attempting to avoid harm to her developing baby. St. Gianna already had three children, but had miscarried twice. She insisted that the last option, the risky surgery, was the only acceptable one. The surgery was successful and she carried her daughter to term. During a difficult labor in April 1962, Gianna Emanuela was delivered by Cesarean section; her mother died a week later from a septic infection, a result of the C-section. St. Gianna was canonized in 2004 with her husband, Pietro, and their surviving children in attendance. It is the first time in history the husband of a saint was present at her canonization. In Molla's speaking event, she regularly boasts of her mother's faith, her Christian witness and her respect for life, especially demonstrated by her sacrifice to give birth to her daughter. "It was her love for Jesus and her love for her husband that supported her through her last pregnancy." St. Gianna was determined her daughter would live, telling her husband and doctors that if there was choice between mother and child at delivery, they must save her baby. "I wouldn't be here if I hadn't been loved so much," Molla has said. "And love is the greatest gift we have to give." St. Gianna was a physician specializing in pediatrics. She is the patron saint of doctors, mothers and unborn children and we celebrated her Feast Day on April 28th. She was also a laywoman with a very strong faith who loved her husband passionately and was devoted to her children. "Their love was so great," Molla has said of her parents. "They lived the sacrament of marriage as a vocation. Dad used to tell me that Mom was a happy wife and a happy mother, and a great physician. She loved all the good things of life. For Momma, everything was a gift from God."

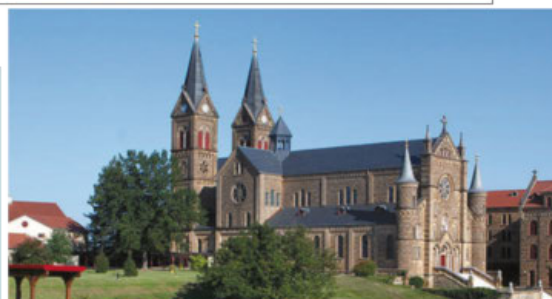

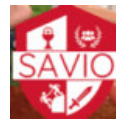
