



Eucharistic Miracle Exhibit

All of the parishes and Catholic schools throughout our diocese - together with all of the dioceses in the U.S. - will be participating in an extraordinary initiative to foster renewed devotion to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist and greater appreciation for the awesome gift of the Mass.

The first Eucharistic Miracle Exhibit will arrive to WCS on or about June 28. This exhibit will transfer to St. Boniface Parish on or about July 5.
