


Rockford Walk for Life-January 15, 2022

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Church holds Christmas as the second most sacred celebration after Easter. Liturgically, Christmas refers to the memorial of Christ's Nativity and His early manifestations which include His baptism as an adult. Thus, today's feast, **the Baptism of the Lord**, is still part of the Christmas celebration and concludes it. We are so used to thinking of Jesus only as an infant during the Season, that an image of Him as adult doesn't often come to mind as part of the Christmas story. In fact, all the daily Gospel readings, from last Sunday's Feast of Epiphany to this Sunday, are adult images of Jesus portraying different qualities of His person in order to reveal what kind of God who became man He is in relation to us. Those portrayed images of Jesus are called His *Epiphanies* or His manifestations in order to answer the question asked in the famous carol: "*What Child is this?*" The ultimate answer to the same question is now given in today's feast; given not by prophets or sages but by God the Father Himself: "This is my beloved Son...Listen to Him." On that note, Christmas is concluded and we are now to listen to the beloved Son of the Father and to follow Him.

The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord is an opportune time to reflect on our own baptism. Most of us were baptized as babies and don't have the privilege of recollecting this momentous event of faith journey like those in the RCIA program. However, our baptism is not an event of the past. Rather it is an ever-present reality, a constant and on-going sharing in the life of the Risen Christ. We can, and we must, reflect on our Baptism as a daily spiritual exercise. Turning to the very words used for the rite of Baptism is an excellent source of help for a most fruitful reflection:

God the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ has freed you from sin, given you a new birth by water and the Holy Spirit, and welcomed you into His holy people.

At Baptism, God, through Christ, has set us free from the bondage of original sin, made us into a new creation through the Holy Spirit by transforming us to become His sons and daughters and brought us into His family, the Church.

He now anoints you with the chrism of salvation as Christ was anointed priest, prophet, and king.

At Baptism we were configured into Christ in His three-fold function as priest, prophet, and king so that as we strive daily to come closer to God in worship and prayer, we also fulfill our roles as helpers in Christ's work of salvation.

As we renew our baptismal vows during this most solemn feast, let us be led by the Spirit to seek the Glory of God in everything that we do. For one last time this year: Merry Christmas to you! And may God bless you.



PAGINA DE ESPANOL - BIENVENIDOS A SANTA MARIA

Para Ti Del Párroco

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

La Iglesia considera la Navidad como la segunda celebración más sagrada después de la Pascua. Litúrgicamente, la Navidad se refiere al memorial de la Natividad de Cristo y Sus primeras manifestaciones, que incluyen Su bautismo como adulto. Por lo tanto, la fiesta de hoy, **El Bautismo del Señor**, todavía es parte de la celebración de Navidad, aunque la concluye. Estamos tan acostumbrados a pensar en Jesús sólo como un infante durante la temporada, que no nos viene a la mente muy a menudo Su imagen adulta como parte de la Navidad. De hecho, todas las lecturas diarias del Evangelio, desde la Fiesta de la Epifanía del pasado domingo hasta este domingo, son imágenes adultas de Jesús que retratan diferentes cualidades de Su persona para revelar qué tipo de Dios hecho hombre es Él en relación a nosotros. Esas imágenes retratadas de Jesús se llaman *Sus Epifanías* o Sus manifestaciones para responder a la pregunta formulada en el famoso villancico "*¿Quién es este niño?*". La respuesta definitiva a la misma pregunta se da en la fiesta de hoy; dada no por profetas o sabios, sino por el mismo Dios Padre: "Este es mi Hijo amado... Escúchenlo". En ese sentido, la Navidad concluye y ahora debemos escuchar al amado Hijo del Padre y seguirlo.

La Fiesta del Bautismo del Señor es un momento oportuno para reflexionar sobre nuestro propio bautismo. La mayoría de nosotros fuimos bautizados cuando éramos bebés y no tenemos el privilegio de recordar este acontecimiento trascendental del viaje de la fe, como los del programa RICA. Sin embargo, nuestro bautismo no es un acontecimiento del pasado. Más bien, es una realidad siempre presente, una participación constante y continua en la vida de Cristo Resucitado. Podemos y debemos reflexionar sobre nuestro bautismo como un ejercicio espiritual continuo y diario. Volver a las palabras utilizadas en el rito del bautismo, es una excelente fuente de ayuda para una reflexión más fructífera:

Dios, el Padre de nuestro Señor Jesucristo, te ha liberado del pecado, te ha dado un nuevo nacimiento por agua y el Espíritu Santo, y te ha recibido en su pueblo santo.

En el bautismo, Dios a través de Cristo nos ha liberado de la esclavitud del pecado original, nos ha convertido en una nueva creación a través del Espíritu Santo al transformarnos en Sus hijos e hijas y nos ha traído a Su familia, la Iglesia.

Ahora te unge con el crisma de la salvación como Cristo fue ungido sacerdote, profeta y rey.

En el bautismo nos configuramos en Cristo en su triple función como sacerdote, profeta y rey, de modo que a medida que nos esforzamos diariamente para acercarnos más a Dios en la adoración y la oración, también hacemos nuestro papel de ayudantes en la obra de salvación de Cristo. Al renovar nuestros votos bautismales durante esta fiesta solemne, seamos guiados por el Espíritu para buscar la Gloria de Dios en todo lo que hacemos. Por última vez este año: ¡Feliz Navidad para ustedes! Y que Dios los bendiga.


