## From the Pastor's Desk

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The deepest meaning of our faith in Jesus Christ is that He is God the Son who became man to reconcile us to God the Father by the power of love — the Holy Spirit.

We could say that Jesus Christ is a reconciliation event. This is what He is always doing — uniting and restoring.

Therefore, the mission of the Church, the people in union with Jesus, is to reconcile. The Roman Catholic Church is a reconciliation movement. Everything the church believes and teaches can be understood as having a role in reconciling the person to God and to his or her self.

Our readings today speak of God's desire to unite us as one in Himself.

Gospel of Mathew:

His heart was moved with pity for them, but they were like sheep without a shepherd. . .

Jeremiah:

I myself will gather the remnant of my flock from all the lands to which I've driven them and bring them back to their meadow; there they shall increase and multiply.

Saint Paul:

Brothers and sisters: In Christ Jesus you who once were far off have become near by the blood of Christ. . . He came and preached peace to you who are far off and peace to those who were near, for through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father.

The meeting point where we are one and where we receive power to reconcile throughout the week is the Eucharistic Feast — the Holy Mass. Jesus, the Eucharist, is Reconciler and Healer. His Holy Love is always flowing from the altar and tabernacle. Let us receive Him, partake of this power, and live so as to draw people into the Feast of Christ's love and the Mass and in the life of our parish.
